ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 70 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES ENTITLED "TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES" BY AMENDING ARTICLE IV - "PARKING STOPPING STANDING", DIVISION 5, "RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT PROGRAM", SECTION 70-249, TO PROVIDE PERMIT HOLDERS THE RIGHT TO PARK IN THE CITY'S METERED PARKING LOTS LOCATED AT TRUMAN WATERFRONT FOR A PERIOD OF TIME NOT TO EXCEED FOUR HOURS PER DAY FREE OF CHARGE: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Residential Parking Permit ordinance will promote the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and visitors of the City of Key West.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That Section 70-249 of the Code of
Ordinances is hereby amended as follows*:

Sec. 70-249. Additional eligibility.

- (c) All persons displaying a lawfully issued

 Residential Parking Permit may park free of charge for a

 period of time not to exceed four(4) hours per day in the

 following City parking sites:
- (i) The main parking lot located at the Key West Bight (Caroline Street lot);
 - (ii) The Old Town Garage, and:;
 - (iii) The Fire Station parking lot on Angela Street.;
 - (iv.) The Truman Waterfront parking lots.

The City Manager may suspend this parking permit benefit at his or her discretion during special event periods or when otherwise required for City purposes.

Section 2: If any section, provision, clause, phrase, or application of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefrom and shall be construed as

reasonable and necessary to achieve the lawful purposes of this Ordinance.

Section 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of said City in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby superseded to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
