
An application was received requesting the removal of **(2) Royal Poinciana trees**. A site inspection was done and documented the following:


Tree Species: Royal Poinciana (Delonix regia)









Location: 80% (on City right of way)
Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 20% (very poor, severe storm damaged to main canopy, trunk

torqued, decay, new growth is sucker growth)

Total Average Value = 66%

Value x Diameter = 14.4 replacement caliper inches






































Tree #2:

Diameter: 21.3"

Location: 80% (on City right of way) Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 30% (poor, major decay at base of tree, in main trunk, and in branches, fungi in torn main branch, poor canopy structure-one sided with heavy growth on opposite side of major trunk decay, potential failure of

tree)

Total Average Value = 70%

Value x Diameter = 14.9 replacement caliper inches

Recommendation: Recommend approval of the removal of one (2) Royal Poinciana trees at 1111 Georgia Street along the Eliza side right-of-way to be replaced with a total of 29.3 caliper inches of dicot or fruit trees from approved list, FL#1, to be planted on site.



Nice talking with you today. Attached are the pictures of the two Poinciana trees severely damaged by Irma. They are on the city right of way on Eliza Street just to the east of the corner Georgia and Eliza. I own the adjacent property (1111 Georgia Street). What I call tree #1 is only a 6 ft high stump that is starting to put out limbs but will never be a real tree again. Tree #2 looks to have lost half its canopy and what remains seems unstable and could fall on the house next door (owned by Nancy Klingener and Mark Heddon). There are two other trees that look ok, especially for their age—I think my house protected them during the hurricane.

Thanks for your consideration. I welcome your assessment and will assist in any way I can.
