A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA), APPROVING A TWO-YEAR EXTENSION TO THE "AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CRA AND ADEPT PUBLIC RELATIONS, LLC FOR MARKETING SERVICES AT KEY WEST HISTORIC SEAPORT"; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 15-371, the CRA awarded a contract to Adept Strategy and Public Relations in Response to RFP #10-015 for marketing services at the Key West Historic Seaport, and in Resolution 16-326, the financial terms of the contract were amended and in Resolution 16-375 terms were further clarified; and

WHEREAS, Article 4 of the contract sets forth an initial term of three years, with a provision for additional two-year extensions, and the Key West Bight Management District Board recommended approval of a two-year extension at its meeting on October 10, 2018; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR

AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a two-year extension to the Agreement between the CRA and Adept Public Relations, LLC for Marketing Services for the Key West Historic Seaport is hereby approved.

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents that are consistent with the approval granted herein, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect
