A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING ON A SOURCE SOLE PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(1) FOR BRAND NAME ITEMS IN ACCORDANCE WITH 2-844 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES AND SECTION 2-797(4)(B) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES THE ATTACHED PROPOSAL OF ALLIGATOR ALLEY HARLEY DAVIDSON IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$28,556.88 (INCLUSIVE OF TRADE-IN) FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO 2019 HARLEY DAVIDSON ROAD KING MOTORCYCLES FOR USE BY THE KEY WEST POLICE DEPARTMENT TRAFFIC UNIT: AUTHORIZING TRADE-IN OF TWO USED 2015 HARLEY DAVIDSON ROAD KING MOTORCYCLES PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-771(c) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Police Department finds that Harley Davidson Road King Police motorcycles best meet department needs based on performance, rider training, maintenance and service history and, in conjunction with the purchasing agent, has determined that a name brand specification is necessary, pursuant to Section 2-844 of the Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, City staff obtained price quotes from the two vendors within reasonable distance from Key West for factory authorized service and maintenance, and determined that the quote, including trade-in, provided by Alligator Alley Harley Davidson of Sunrise was the lowest price; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached proposal for purchase from Alligator Alley Harley Davidson of Sunrise for two Harley Davidson Road King motorcycles, with accessories, in the total amount of \$28,556.88 plus the trade-in of two 2015 Harley Davidson Road King motorcycles, is hereby accepted pursuant to Sections 2-797(1), 2-797(4)(b) and 2-844 of the Code of Ordinances.

Section 2: That the disposal (trade-in) of two obsolete City-owned 2015 Harley Davidson Road King motorcycles, to be used toward the purchase of new motorcycles described above, is authorized pursuant to Section to 2-771(c) of the Code of Ordinances.

Section 3: That funding for this purchase is budgeted in account #101-2101-521-6400 for police department machinery and equipment for FY 18-19.

Section 4: That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute any necessary paperwork, upon consent of the City Attorney.
