AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 110 OF THE CODE ORDINANCES, ENTITLED "RESOURCE PROTECTION" BY AMENDING ARTICLE VI ENTITLED PROTECTION", CREATING SECTION 110-261 TO BE TITLED "HERITAGE TREES", TO PROVIDE FOR THE CREATION OF A HERITAGE TREE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS: PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission for the City of Key West finds that some trees are historically significant, associated with a notable local or regional historical event, person, structure, or landscape, has been dedicated or planted as a public memorial, or its species is important to the history of Key West; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Board for the City of Key West approved this ordinance revision at their meeting of November 15, 2018; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That Section 110-261 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows\*:

## Sec. 110-261. - Heritage Trees.

- (a) The Tree Commission shall create a Heritage Tree Program. Applications will be accepted in a form accepted by the Tree Commission for consideration of trees into the Heritage Tree Program. The Urban Forester shall process the applications for consideration. The Tree Commission shall review complete applications and make the final determination.
- Applications for the Heritage Tree Program must meet (b) at least one of the following criteria:
  - 1. Trees that are historically significant to the history of Key West;
  - 2. Trees that are associated with a notable local or regional historical event, person, structure, or landscape;
  - 3. Trees that have been dedicated or planted as a public memorial;
  - 4. Trees whose species is important to the history of Key West.

- vote of the Tree Commission, such tree(s) shall enjoy
  the same protections as Specially Protected Trees
  pursuant to Sec. 110-253.
- (d) A designation of a Heritage Tree by the Tree

  Commission may be appealed to the city commission

  pursuant to Sec. 110-337 by the current owner of the

  Heritage Tree at the time the appeal is made.
- Section 2: If any section, provision, clause, phrase, or application of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefrom and shall be construed as reasonable and necessary to achieve the lawful purposes of this Ordinance.
- Section 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of said
  City in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby
  superseded to the extent of such conflict.

Section $4$ : This Ordinance shall go into effect immediately	
upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the	
signature of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission	
and approval by the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity,	
pursuant to Chapter 380, Florida Statutes.
