AND SUNDAY, JANUARY 20th, 2019 FROM 11:00 A.M. TO 5:00 P.M; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

SECTION 2. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, the Monroe County Commercial Fishermen, Inc. is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.
