A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING A TASK ORDER UNDER THE CITY'S GENERAL UTILITIES SERVICES CONTRACT WITH D.N. HIGGINS, INC. IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$80,285.45 FOR HURRICANE IRMA REPAIRS TO REYNOLDS STREET STORMWATER OUTFALL; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 15-292, the City Commission approved a three-year General Utilities Services contract with Douglas N. Higgins, and in Resolution 18-322 the contract was extended for two years; and

WHEREAS, Hurricane Irma made landfall in Key West on September 10, 2017, with resulting storm surge and wave action causing significant damage to the Reynolds Street outfall, including tide valve vault, piping and other equipment; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a Task Order for Reynold Street Stormwater Outfall Repair, under the City's General Utilities Contract with Douglas N. Higgins, Inc., is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$80,285.45.

Section 2: That funds for this project will be paid from Utilities/Stormwater/Collection System/CIP account 402-3803-538-6500, Project HU1701F04. This project will be submitted upon completion to FEMA for possible Federal and State reimbursement, due to Hurricane Irma damage, and any necessary budget transfers are authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute necessary documents upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
