AGS already has a substantial presence in South Florida at various port locations, securing our Nation's borders and protecting passengers, client property, and more. At PortMiami, Port of Tampa, Port Canaveral, and several others, AGS follows all USCG and MTSA regulations—and was the first firm to implement/deploy stricter security measures and tactics post 9/11. We are now seeking Safety Act designation from the Department of Homeland Security to limit our liability, so that we can spend more resources on operational anti-terrorism awareness and training.

Passenger screening (as many as 10 million per season total) at dozens of port locations for peak season tourist embarkations is no small accomplishment. After all, the total population of Monroe County, using 2017 figures, is 77,000.

We also must note that our coverage and support to numerous Southern California municipalities extends to over 2,200 square miles. The entirety of Monroe County is 3,738 square miles.

This year, AGS received two awards—one in Clearwater, Florida—securing their municipal buildings and busy downtown district/marina—and another providing facial recognition systems to four facilities on the campus of Florida State University. On April 21st, we provided executive level protection for NBC camera/production crews and management during a high-visibly protest. More executive protection jobs are expected in the future with NBC and others as this is a crucial scope component of our Master Purchase Agreement with TEGNA.

Port Canaveral

AGS supports the Visible Intermodal Prevention and Response (VIPR) operation at the Port. VIPR operations are designed to augment the security of port operations/security, but could apply to any mode of transportation. This was particularly effective on March 18th, 2010 when we were observed and inspected by TSA Team Orlando.



PortMiami

AGS has a significant presence at PortMiami and has unveiled two groundbreaking technologies at the port to improve passenger experience, minimize wait times, and optimize CIP spend. These include the first dual-view x-ray screener for cruise use and the first Proof of Concept using facial recognition to onboard guests/arrivals.

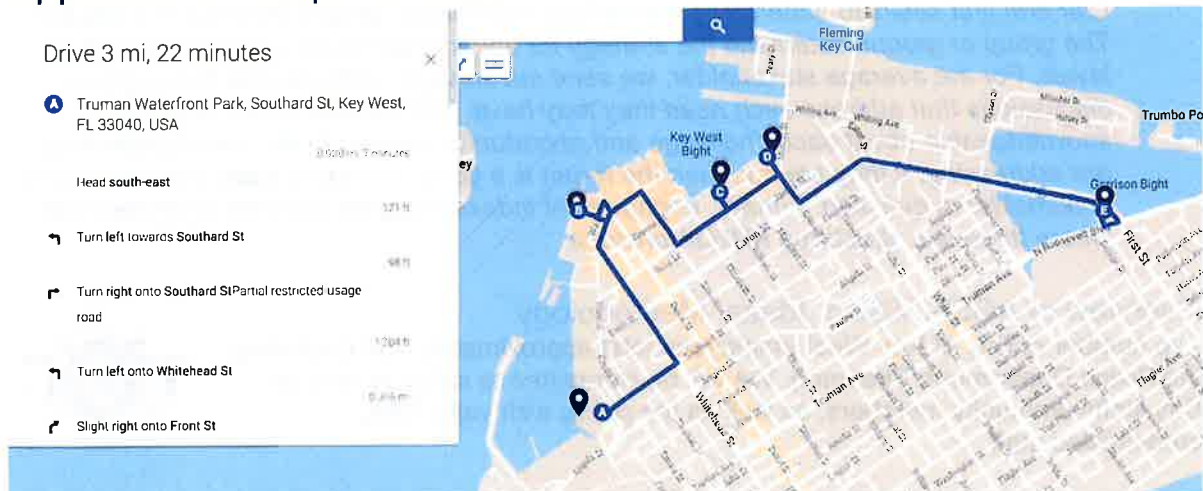

Approach to Scope of Work



Above: The total distance between the five (5) locations is three (3) miles, which is 75% of the island's total length. Whether we are providing coverage for 2,000 square miles or eight, the AGS approach is tailored for each client location.

Project Understanding/Approach Needs, Goals, and Objectives

Key West attracts tourists, servicemen, and maritime travelers, but it also attracts democracy-loving residents that commit to preserving the City's values through ambassador programs, for example. We will commit to hiring from the City's local pool of qualified safeguards to keep its public sites secure.

More on our understanding of the City:

- Key West is consistently rated high as a tourist destination. We will provide visually appealing and professional uniforms, customer service, and added value from the start.
- Winter is the busiest season for tourism and requires all City functions, including security, to operate smoothly.
- The City's Police Department's mission is to provide effective and efficient police services. This mission, along with its core values, are aligned with ours.

More on our understanding of the Project:

- Mallory Square is frequently busy from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm. In particular, a drastic difference in crowd density and intensity is present during those times. The popular location has faced vagrancy/transiency issues in the past; our approach will consider past issues and work to mitigate future occurrences.
- Marinas and boaters (in general) desire increased security measures but not intrusive policies or structures.
- City-managed marinas and other maritime structures/terminals have been allocated an increasing amount of funds from the City year after year for security. We will honor this investment with effective but cost-efficient security solutions which utilize the taxpayers' funds to the fullest.

AGS's *unique brand of engagement* with key stakeholders will be given priority. Our engagement philosophy is described more below:

Our firm first seeks to understand the various stakeholder groups involved in a project. The group or groups determine the strategy for advancing/enhancing engagement levels. For the average stakeholder, we send out surveys and schedule focus group discussions that address each need they may have. The liaisons on our end are knowledgeable about each challenge and opportunity relevant to the stakeholder they are addressing; if they are not, then the forum is a good chance to learn more about the stakeholder in question. Further, engagement indexes may be used for large contracts where there is a structured KPI/QA process.

Overview of AGS's Vision, Ideas, Methodology

The number of City of Key West employees total approximately 500 (including the Police Department, Fire, etc.). We will be committed to safeguarding all City staff/community members, as well as the public with valid TWIC credentialed staff.



Our soft approach for securing public venues like Mallory Square aligns with the Key West Police Department's community-policing policies. Our methodology for securing marinas and port terminals is non-intrusive without compromising safety. These site-specific solutions (and others matching the carefully studied needs of each City location) are integral to our *tailored approach philosophy*. This approach is not possible without the extensive research and stakeholder engagement we use to identify client expectations and deepen our understanding of project needs.

To source the requisite guard totals, we will pull from qualified incumbent pools and criminal justice graduates from Florida Keys Community College, a member tied to our partner, E&I. Emergency response times, while relatively short, will be kept low while working with the City's Emergency Operations Center, Post-Disaster Task Force, Hazard Mitigation agencies, and so on.



A KEY WEST-SPECIFIC SECURITY FOCUS



AGS's Current Workload

AGS is poised to devote ample time, attention, guards, and other resources to the City. We are prepared to make adjustments to our workload to fit in the contract necessities, etc. and see no future barrier to a highly performance-based partnership.

We are built for growth and exhibit constant readiness for new projects.

Monthly meetings with KYPD and regular site visits by supervisors are well within our current capabilities.

Available Staff, Facilities, Capabilities, and Other Resources

South Florida is our largest operational base outside of the Los Angeles metro area; hiring, credentialing, staffing, and retaining for contracts in the local area has become our specialty. We also operate four offices in the State and pledge to open a supporting local office in Key West, upon award if needed.

The following could be considered "Other Resources" available to City:

- **FaceEx**—a facial recognition brand—and its people counting/identifying ability is a substantive add-on that is available to complement our service.
- Electric Trikkies are a viable option for the open terrain of Mallory Square.
- Advanced Anti-Terrorism for port environments and city parks.
- Guard training to identify, document, and report unregistered vessels.
- Over a decade worth of experience credentialing guards for TWIC.
 - The TWIC certification process can lead to complications for unprepared firms. For guards who do not already possess a TWIC card, we e-verify that they are lawful U.S. citizens and ensure they meet all other TWIC requirements. TWIC applicants must pass security assessments 8 to 12 weeks beforehand, making the process a long one that most contract transition phases do not allot sufficient time for. Therefore, we prepare non-TWIC guards to be certified long in advanced on a strategic (for future contracts) timeframe, rather than a contract-based one. Consequently, we prefer staffing all port security sites with incumbent guards with pre-existing TWIC certification.

Management Position

Because of the contract requirements and site specifics, we agree that a flexible, (permanently) local supervisory presence is best suited for this project. We wish to find the best suited individual and will have him or her ready for their duties before the start date. *The list of qualifications below will influence our determination for employment/assignment:*



In addition, this individual:

- Must be able to multitask and prioritize departmental functions to meet deadlines.
- Approach all encounters with the public and City employees in an attentive, friendly, courteous and service-oriented manner.
- Must attend all KYPD required meetings and trainings.

- Comply with AGS and City of Key West regulations to encourage safe and efficient security operations.
- Will maximize efforts towards productivity, identify problem areas, and assist in implementing solutions.
- Must be effective in handling problems, including anticipating, preventing, identifying and solving problems as necessary.
- Must be able to understand and evaluate complex information, data, etc. from various sources to meet appropriate objectives.
- Must be able to maintain the confidentiality of information.

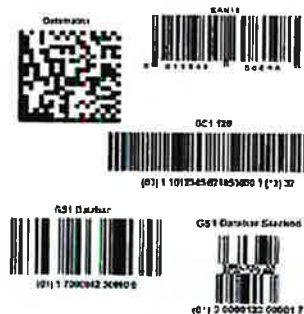



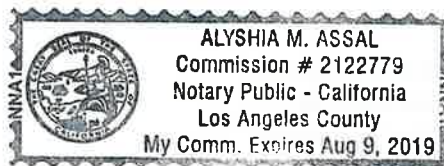
