
An application was received requesting the removal of **(1) Royal Poinciana tree**. Additional information was requested including asking for the removal of the philodendron vine from the tree trunk. Below are photos from a recent inspection of the tree:
























NOTE: Below are the values stated in the original staff report with additional comments based on the recent inspection.

Diameter: 29.9"

Location: 50% (canopy has utility lines going through it, tree growing on filled lot with side of root system held by failing concrete block wall). Root system appears to be strong on opposite side of tree. Are there issues with neighboring property?

Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 60% (fair-no evidence at time of inspection of termite issues. Main trunk covered with philodendron vines-hard to accurately evaluate trunk health. Fresh trim cuts look clean and healthy, some decay and dead branches in canopy-looks very typical of large Royal Poinciana trees in town.) Tree appears to be in fair health. No extensive decay observed in branch junctions. No obvious outward evidence of termites.

Total Average Value = 70%

## Value x Diameter = 20.9 replacement caliper inches

Additional information has been requested from the applicant including impacts to neighboring property/wall and is there an arborist report regarding the health of the canopy.
