On Tuesday, December 04, 2018, approximately 0404 Hours, Officer Dantu, Officer Mogerley and I, Officer Perez, responded to 310 Duval Street (Caroline's), in reference to an aggravated assault involving male with a weapon (Knife). The caller was frantic and told dispatch they need to get the cops down here.

Upon arrival, there was about 5 people there. It was reported that the suspect was swinging a knife around endangering people. Officer Dantu and I identified the suspect. I ordered the suspect to stop several times. the suspect took off running away from the officers east bound on Rose Lane, in order to prevent being detained. Officer Mogerley and I ran after the suspect, we ordered him several times to stop running, suspect ignored our lawful command. Officer Mogerley pulled out his taser and fired at him, suspect continued running. I then pulled out my taser and fired at the suspect, suspect continued running towards Simonton Street. Officer Mogerley advised Comm 1 over the radio the suspect direction of travel. Mean time Officer Dantu, drove on his patrol unit towards the suspect direction of travel and was able to make contact, and took him into custody. The suspect was later identified as Tony Austin Bethel (DOB 07/02/1992).

Mean time I met a witness, later identified as Robert Thomas Arundel (DOB 02/15/1977). Arundel told me he witnessed a disturbance, among Bethel and another Hispanic male, later identified as Jesus Emilio Amaro Torres (DOB 05/26/1989). Arundel said that he was trying to defuse the situation, and Bethel pulled out a knife, Arundel said he then walked across the street to get away from the knife and one of his friends, call the police. I asked Arundel to write a witness statement and was entered into the Key West Police Records Department as evidence.

I then interview the Amaro Torres and he told me he was working at Carolines, when Bethel walked into the property, Amaro Torres asked Bethel to leave the property as they were closed, and Bethel grabbed a beer from a table and threw it on the ground. As Amaro Torres said "I walked after Bethel running him out of the property, Bethel pulled out a knife and almost cut him in the belly area". Amaro Torres said he then threw a couple of punches at Bethel and hit him on the face. He was afraid he was going to be cut with the knife. I asked Amaro Torres to write a statement and the statement was summited into the Key West Police Records Department as evidence.

Bethel then said he was hit with a beer bottle, Bethel was clearly bleeding from the mouth. I found a broken beer bottle on the ground, near the area were the incident happened. Officer Dantu transported Bethel to The Lower Keys Medical Center for medical clearance and then to The Monroe County Detention Center, without incident

Officer Mogerley, Sergeant Duponty and I, canvas the area for several minutes, trying to locate a knife unsuccessfully. My BWC was activated during the event.

Based on the facts, evidence and My investigations, in this case, there is probable cause to believe that on 12/04/2018, at about 0404 Hours, Bethel, did actually and intentionally committed Aggravated Assault with a deadly weapon. By doing so Bethel was in violation of F.S.S 784.021-1A, furthermore Bethel, did knowingly and intentionally disobey Officer Mogerley's and my self's lawful commands violating FSS 843.02 resisting without violence. During my investigation I was informed by Comm 1 of Bethel's probation on previous case. Based on that information Bethel did actually and intentionally violated the

On December 4, 2018 at about 4:03 a.m., Officer Dantu, Perez, and I (Mogerley), were dispatched to an assault that was involving a white male with a knife.

Upon arrival Officer Perez was in foot pursuit with the suspect who was a white male. They were on Duval Street, and running toward Rose Lane. I exited my car and engaged in the foot pursuit. The suspect was ordered to stop several times, but kept running. I could see a metal object in the suspects hand. The suspect was seen swinging a knife around in the street prior to our arrival. I pulled my taser, pointed it at his back, and deployed it. One probe hit his back and the other missed. This was at the intersection of Rose Lane and Duval Street. The suspect did not stop, and he kept running. Officer Perez deployed his taser, but missed the subject. We kept running after the subject down Rose Lane. The subject turned onto Simonton Street. Officer Dantu blocked off the suspect at Eaton Street and Simonton Street. The suspect complied and got onto the ground. Officer Dantu Handcuffed the suspect. Key West Fire and Rescue responded.

I went back to the area and located the victims. They spoke spanish and Officer Perez interviewed them and got statements. Officer Hudson, Sgt. Duponty, and I (Ofc. Mogerley) searched the area on Rose Lane and Duval Street to try to locate the knife. We were unable to locate the knife. It was reported that the suspect had two unidentified friends in the area that may have taken the knife.

Officer Perez found a small bag of a white powder substance next to the suspects bag that he dropped when he took off running. I later weighed and tested the substance at the Key West Police Department. The substance tested positive for cocaine, and weighed 0.5 grams. It was packaged and placed into evidence at the Key West Police Dept.

I placed the used taser cartridges into evidence at the Key West Police Department.

On 12/04/2018, about 0415 hrs, I (Ofc. Dantu) was dispatched to 310 Caroline Street, (Caroline's Restaurant) in reference to a man threatening people with a knife.

Upon arrival, I saw 3 men fighting on the side walk. Ofc. Perez and Ofc. Mogerley arrived on scene. I exited my vehicle. One of the men, (Tony Bethal) fled the scene and ran up Rose Lane towards Simonton Street.

Ofc. Perez and Ofc. Mogerley ran after Bethal. I got back into my police vehicle and drove to the corner of Eaton and Simonton Street in an attempt to intercept Bethal.

When I arrived at the intersection at Simonton St. and Eaton Street I saw Bethal approaching the intersection. I drove my vehicle towards him, stopped my vehicle, got out of my vehicle and walked towards Bethal. I told Bethal to stop and to get down on the ground. He continued to walk towards me. I pulled out my Handgun and pointed at Bethal. I told Bethal to get on the ground face down. Bethal complied. I handcuffed Bethal. Bethal did not resist. I detained Bethal.

Bethal was bleeding from the left corner of his mouth. Sgt. Duponty arrived on scene. Ofc. Mogerley was on scene. Ofc. Gillespie was on scene. Ofc. Hudson was on scene.

Rescue arrived on scene and attended to Bethal. Bethal was not transported to Lower Keys Medical Center. Bethal had a taser prong sticking out of his upper back.

Ofc. Gillespie and I transported Bethal to the Lower Keys Medical Center before I transported him to Monroe County Detention Center. Bethal started to bang his head on the back window when placed into my vehicle. Bethal was hobble tied to prevent himself from causing injury.

Bethal was examined at Lower Keys Medical Center and released. I transported Bethal to Monroe County Detention Center. Ofc. Perez was the primary Ofc. on the case. Ofc. Perez was at the Monroe County Detention Center. Ofc. Perez arrested Bethal for:

Aggravated Assault, Probation Violation, Resisting an Officer without Violence
