On Sunday, December 23, 2018 at approximately 1345 hours, I, Ofc. Ane, responded to the Outermole to assist Ofc. T. Stevens and Ofc. B. Rogers, with several complaints on a cruise ship.

Initially, I was assisting Ofc. T. Stevens with a battery investigation. I was attempting to watch a surveillance video, when another security officer for the cruise ship asked that I report to the front entrance of the ship, because a guest was threatening their staff.

When I got to the front entrance, I saw several security guards being yelled at by three males. I approached the first male and told him to calm down. He immediately reared his shoulders back and balled his fists. I told him to stop posturing and come speak to their staff, which he complied. As we were walking away with the aforementioned male, his son, Austin Grossvenor, attempted to follow us. I told Grossvenor to stay back, while we spoke to his father. Grossvenor ignored me and attempted to walk past me. I put my hand on his abdomen and told him needed to stay back. Grossvenor again attempted to walk past me and when I explained to him that he would be arrested if he continued, he called me an "Asshole", then backed away.

Grossvenor's father and I walked away with the cruise ship's staff and began to speak about why he was upset. While security and Grossvenor's father were speaking, I heard Grossvenor yell out several times. Grossvenor was upset about being separated and yelled "Asshole" several times, along with several other profanities.

The area where Grossvenor was screaming profanities was filled with guests, which included several young children, waiting to exit the ship. I walked back over to Grossvenor and began to explain to him that if he were to continue screaming profanities in front of children and families, he would be subject to arrest for Disorderly Conduct. As I was speaking to Grossvenor, it was clear he did not care as to what I was saying and he attempted to walk away from me towards the security staff and his father.

I grabbed Grossvenor's left arm and told him to stay with me. He immediately tensed his body and pulled his arm away from me. I grabbed Grossvenor's arm again and told him to come to me. Grossvenor again tensed his body and pushed into me. At this point, I performed a modified leg sweep and redirected Grossvenor to the ground. Grossvenor was on his hands and knees and continued to tense himself, so I could not put his arms behind his back. I gave Grossvenor several loud commands to place his hands behind his back, or I would use more force to do so. The struggle with Grossvenor lasted for approximately 30-45 seconds. Grossvenor eventually complied and placed his hands behind back.

I placed Grossvenor in handcuffs and contacted Sgt. Blasberg to notify him of my response to resistance.

I transported Grossvenor to MCDC without incident.

This investigation was recorded via my department issued body worn camera, which I later uploaded to evidence.com.

Austin Grossvenor is being charged with one count of Resisting w/o violence, contrary to FSS. 843.02
