On 11/29/2018, 12:37 a.m., I was dispatched to a report of a male having a seizure at the intersection of Green Street and Whitehead Street in the City of Key West. Key West Fire and Rescue were also dispatched.

Upon arrival there was a male, later identified as Nicholas Glenn (dob:06/28/1996), on the sidewalk with his friend over him. There was a shirtless male and a female in the same area. I spoke with them as Rescue attended to Glenn. The female later identified as Amber Lanch, told me that she was walking on Green Street and that Glenn was running down the street. Glenn ran into her, knocking her into a fence. Lanch said that he kept running and he ran into her. Lanch did not want to press charges for Glenn running into her.

Glenn was reported to have taken lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD), and was having a very bad reaction to the drug. Key West Rescue transported him to the Lower Keys Medical Center. Glenn was not combative at this time but rescue asked that I ride with them to the Emergency Room.

While driving to the ER, Glenn started to swing his arms around and was grabbing the Rescue personal. I handcuffed him to the stretcher. Glenn became very aggressive and I had to hold his body down. Rescue was attempting to administer a shot of Ketamine to Glenn, and Glenn was trying to kick them. Glenn was kicking aggressively. I moved to the lower part of the stretcher, and expanded my baton. I placed my baton across his lower legs and pushed them down. I had his legs pinned between my baton and the stretcher. His right leg broke free and he kicked me in my left rib area. I moved, and Glenn started kicking at me again. I delivered a baton strike to his upper left thigh (left quadricep), as he was trying to kick me. This caused Glenn to stop kicking, and I gained control of his legs holding them back down against the stretcher. Rescue was able to administer Ketamine, and Glenn was no longer combative once the Ketamine took effect.

When Glenn kicked me his foot made contact with my left rib, but I did not cause any pain or injuries.

Glenn was turned over to the Lower Keys Medical Center, where he was admitted and given more medication and medical care.

I reviewed the incident with Sgt. Duponty and due to the lack of criminal intent and excited delirium, charges were not filed against Glenn. Glenn was tuned over to the Emergency Room for Medical Care.

My body camera was knocked off prior to me being able to activate it, and it was later found on the ambulance floor.
