WHEREAS, March 18, 1662 is believed to be the first day of scheduled public transit bus service for Blaise Pascal's "Five-Penny Coaches" in the City of Paris.

WHEREAS, In 2018 American Public Transit Agencies provided more than 10.4 billion trips on public transportation; Key West Transit provided service for more than 619,000 passengers.

WHEREAS, For hours on end, our operators provide an essential service that strengthens our community and economy by safely and expertly delivering people to their destination by maneuvering an extra-large vehicle through tedious unpredictable traffic and narrow thoroughfares in all weather conditions.
