This sculpture theme of Mermaids, King Neptune and possibly Dolphins and other sea creatures was chosen in part because it is neutral and does not make any kind of possible controversial social statement, but instead will simply just stretch the imagination, uplift the spirit, inspire and be fun. I believe that part of our goal should be to reach for the spectacular and not just settle for the mediocre, and we can accomplish that by bringing to our Park world class, museum quality works of art in the form of sculptures that can stand up to any city's art in the world.

The other part of the goal is to make a potential donor or donors aware that there is a golden opportunity waiting for them to have their memory live on in Key West for a lifetime of recognition and personal satisfaction....with a generous gift of one or more of these beautiful, interesting and classy sculptures to our already great Park.

The Mission and Duties of the Truman Waterfront Advisory Board:

- To make recommendations to the City Commission and LRA on all items and issues related to the entire Truman Waterfront area for the improvements of the Truman Waterfront.
- To promote the rehabilitation, revitalization, conservation and redevelopment of lands and structures within the Truman Waterfront.
- Advise the City Commission on projects and uses for the property which are consistent with the comprehensive plan and conveyance documents from the United States.
- Explore funding sources to offset any potential taxpayer burden.
- Study the feasibility of proposed projects and the viability of future projects.
- Facilitate productive communication and elicit opinions from all interested individuals and entities, especially the United States Navy.
