The Conch Republic (also known as Key West and the Florida Keys) was born from trouble; dating back to the dark days of March 1982 when the U.S. Federal Government placed a Border Patrol Roadblock at the Last Chance Saloon in Florida City.

WHEREAS

Community leaders gathered around Mayor Dennis Wardlow as the very lifeblood of a budding tourism industry was threatened and Key West was headed to federal courted. They lost but never gave up! Mayor Wardlow stated that if the Keys were to be treated as a foreign country, the only recourse would be to secede;

WHEREAS

On April 23rd, 1982, the Conch Republic flag was raised over city hall and the Schooner Western Union went forth into the harbor and attacked the US Coast Guard Cutter DILIGENCE with water balloons, Conch fritters and stale Cuban bread. The DILIGENCE fought back with fire hoses and thus commenced the Great Battle of the Conch Republic. Prime Minister Wardlow surrendered and demanded foreign aid from the United States (which is still pending);

A celebration of independence shall be held from April 19 thru the 29th, LONG LIVE THE CONCH REPUBLIC!
