- 1. I, (owner) hereby agree to indemnify the City of Key West, its employees, agents, and invitees, from any injuries to person, and/or damage to property as a result of participation in this (these) event(s). This indemnification shall survive the dates of use described above.
- 2. I, (owner) hereby agree to carry Commercial General Liability insurance with minimum limits of \$1,000,000, with the City of Key West named as an "Additional Insured." This policy is not "Site Specific." I am providing the City a Certificate of Insurance (COI) with this application.
- 3. IF SERVING ALCOHOL: I, (owner) hereby agree to maintain <u>Full</u> Liquor Liability coverage with minimum limits of \$1,000,000. Please note the word <u>Full</u>. A standard Commercial General Liability policy provides limited Liquor Liability coverage but does not apply to businesses that sell, manufacture or distribute alcoholic beverages. This limited Liquor Liability coverage is commonly referred to as "Host Liquor Liability" coverage. The City shall be named as an "Additional Insured" on the required Liquor Liability policy. Any required extension or amended sketch of licensed premises permit shall be approved by the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco (DBPR ABT – 6029)
- 4. The public Right-of-Way (ROW) averages 50' wide for entire length of Duval. Businesses may extend 17' into ROW from the face of building at each end of their property line.
- 5. A clear, 4' travel lane for wheel chair access must be maintained on all sidewalks and a 16' clear travel lane for Emergency Services must be maintained in roadway.
- 6. Canopies, tents, umbrellas, etc. shall be securely anchored (with no damage to pavement).
- 7. There will be no sub-leasing of property or encroached ROW.
- 8. There will be no preparation of food or beverages within the ROW.
- 9. Glass beverage containers are prohibited (cans/plastic only).
- 10. Without exception, no delivery vehicles in pilot project zone after 5 pm.
