
An application was received requesting the removal of **(1) Gumbo Limbo tree**. A site inspection was done and documented the following:


## Tree Species: Gumbo Limbo (Bursera simaruba)



























Weeping sap





Diameter: 21.9"

Location: 60% (in deck between two structures)

Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 40% (fair to poor, large trunk decay area-old injury?, decay extends down into base of trunk-potential structural failure of canopy, weeping sap near branch crotch area, weeping sap area in old branch cut in canopy)

Total Average Value = 66%

#### Value x Diameter = 14.4 replacement caliper inches
