A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE REPAIR OF THE TRANSIT FACILITY 80-KW GENERATOR SET BY OK GENERATORS, DESCRIBED IN THE ATTACHED PRICE QUOTE DATED MARCH 21, 2019 FROM OK GENERATORS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$24,671.00 IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE CITY, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(4)(b) OF CODE THE OF ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Hurricane Irma made landfall in Key West on September 10, 2017, and during heavy use for emergency operations, the transit facility generator became inoperative; and

WHEREAS, a request for funding for replacement or repair of this equipment, and other Key West Transit recovery costs, was included in a Federal Transit Administration (FTA) - Emergency Relief Program application, and funds have been allocated on a reimbursement basis; and

WHEREAS, staff obtained three price quotes from vendors that visited the site, and determined that OK Generators submitted the lowest cost responsive and responsible proposal; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the repair of the Transit Facility 80 KW Generator Set by OK Generators, as described in the attached price quote dated March 21, 2019, in an amount not to exceed \$24,671.00 is hereby approved, in the best interests of the City, pursuant to Section 2-797(4) of the Code of Ordinances.

Section 2: This purchase will be reimbursed through an FTA Emergency Relief Program at 90% (FTA share \$22,203.90/City Share \$2,467.10). Adequate funds for the project are budgeted in Transit Fund 411-4403-544-6400. Any necessary budget adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute any necessary documents on behalf of the City of Key West, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
