I have been licensed to practice law in the State of Florida since 1985, in the State of Colorado since 1994 and have resided in Key West and Monroe County since 1987. I am a Florida Bar member in good standing since 1985 with no disciplinary actions or disbarment in any state.

The Supreme Court of Florida certified me as a Mediator in Circuit and County Court in 1993, in Family Court in 1998, as an Arbitrator in 1995 and as a Residential Foreclosure Mediator in 2010. My mediation and arbitration experience has involved every facet of the law except criminal and domestic violence (which do not allow for mediation).
