AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE III ENTITLED "OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES", BY CREATING DIVISION 4 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED "CITY CLERK"; ADDING SECTION 2-302, ENTITLED "CITY CLERK SELECTION PROCESS" TO SPECIFY A PROCESS BY WHICH THE CITY COMMISSION SELECTS A NEW CITY CLERK; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, City Charter article 4.07 provides "The city clerk shall be appointed and removed by the city commission..."; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that it is necessary to create a process to supplement the Charter to guide the City Commission in the selection of the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the enactment of a new section 2-302 of the Code of Ordinances will promote the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and visitors of the City of Key West.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That Division 4, Section 2-302 of the
Code of Ordinances entitled "City Clerk Selection Process"
is hereby created as follows*:

Division 4. City Clerk

Sec. 2-302. - City Clerk Selection Process.

- (a) Any contract between the City and its City Clerk
 shall include a minimum of 6 months' notice of non-renewal,
 resignation or retirement in order to allow for sufficient
 planning purposes.
- (b) Within a maximum of one month after the receipt of such notice and determination of the need for the hiring of a new City Clerk, the City Commission by resolution shall:
 - 1. Revise, if necessary, the job description and minimum qualifications for the City Clerk;
 - 2. Approve an application form and required submittals for the City Clerk position;

- 3. Establish area of search for potential candidates;
- 4. Establish timelines for
 - (A) advertising position;
 - (B) receipt of applications;
 - (C) conducting interviews;
 - (D) selection of City Clerk;
 - (E) execution of contract; and
 - (F) any other matters determined necessary to select the most qualified and capable individual to hold the position of Key West City Clerk.

Section 2: If any section, provision, clause, phrase, or application of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefrom and shall be construed as reasonable and necessary to achieve the lawful purposes of this Ordinance.

Section 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of said City in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby superseded to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4 : This Ordinance shall go into effect	-
