

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST,
FLORIDA, AMENDING THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM
FOR GENERAL EMPLOYEES; AMENDING CHAPTER
46, SECTION 63 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
EXTENDING TRUSTEE TERMS TO FOUR YEARS;
PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR
CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Retirement System for General Employees has recommended certain revisions to the plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the recommendations are in the best interest of the City, the taxpayers, and the plan participants;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Commission of the City of Key West:

Section 1. Chapter 46, Article II, Section 46-63 of the Key West City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 46-63. Terms; vacancy.

- (a) ~~The elected active employee representative position expiring next after the passage of this ordinance shall be appointed for a term of three years. The two remaining elected active employee representatives shall be elected to a term of two years. The member appointed by the mayor and city commission shall be appointed to a term of three years. The member appointed by a majority of the board shall be appointed to a term of two years.~~ **All members of the board of trustees shall serve a four year term. All trustees serving as of July 1, 2019 shall have their current terms extended so that the length of the term is four years.**
- (b) If a vacancy shall occur prior to the expiration of a trustee's term, a replacement trustee shall be chosen in the same manner as the trustee who has left office. A replacement trustee shall serve a full term measured from the date of replacement.
- (c) All trustees shall serve until their replacements are selected.

Section 2. Should any section of this ordinance be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall be in full force and effect as if the invalid provision had not been adopted.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be codified in the Key West City Code. The editor of the Code shall be authorized to renumber or re-letter sections as may be necessary.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
