Emergency Procurement: Mallory Square Breasting Dolphin Construction

On November 24, 2018 the Cruise Ship Silver Spirit damaged beyond repair the southernmost breasting dolphin at Mallory Square Pier. In order to minimize the financial impact from either having to cancel or relocate cruise ships and to construct a new breasting dolphin, City staff has moved forward the repairs as quickly as possible.

The main phase of the work is the actually construction of the new breasting delphin. The City sent the bid documents directly to four (4) contractors which included a very aggressive schedule for completion:

Request for Quotes: 2/11/19

Quotes Due: 2/19/19

Notice of Award: 2/21/19

Notice to Proceed: 3/4/19

Project Completion: 4/17/19

The City received two (2) quotes:

Ebsary Foundation: \$548,500

Kearns Construction:\$1,028,00

Per Section 2-797(2) the city manager may make emergency procurement of commodities or contractual services where the cost exceeds \$20,000.00 when there exists a clear and present threat to public health, property, welfare, safety or other substantial loss to the city.

This emergency procurements will be ratified by the city commission.
