On July 16, 2019, at approximately 2112 hours, I (Ofc Valdes Marrero) was working an off-duty detail at 1213 14th St (Stadium Mobile Home Park). I was parked on the 14th St side of Stadium Mobile Home Park and I observed a light-colored vehicle which, I visually estimated was traveling 37MPH on a 20MPH zone. The vehicle was traveling Northbound, towards Northside Drive. There is to note I have completed my speed measurement and radar certification required by FDLE.

I attempted to catch up with the vehicle, which made a right turn into Northside Drive heading Eastbound. The vehicle then pulled into the back-parking lot of Searstown, near the flower section. As I pulled behind the vehicle, I activated my emergency lights in my police car. The vehicle was a white in color Ford Fusion, bearing Florida license plate CTGU13.

The driver (later identified as Derek L. Shine per his FL DL), exited the vehicle and was reaching inside the front pockets of his shorts. I told Shine several times not to reach inside his pockets due to officer safety. Shine reached once again in his pockets and I attempted to detain him. I grabbed Shine's arm in an escort position to try and place him in handcuffs. Shine pushed and pulled away from me and was able to get away from me. Shine ran through the back-parking lot of Searstown, towards Outback. I deployed my agency issued Taser device in an attempt to stop Shine, but I was unsuccessful. I continued chasing Shine on foot through the parking lot of Outback and T.J. Max. I lost sight of Shine between all the parked cars in the parking lot.

I radioed a BOLO of Shine's description to the other responding units. Several officers canvased the area to no avail. I returned back to the vehicle to continue my investigation. I could smell a strong odor of burnt marijuana emanating from the vehicle. There was "shake" (marijuana residue) all over the floorboard of the driver side. There was also a "roach" (leftover small piece of marijuana blunt) on the ground, next to the driver side of the vehicle. I decided to tow the vehicle since it was part of a criminal investigation.

I conducted an inventory of the vehicle and I located Shine's cellphone on the driver seat. There were several text messages from Shine's girlfriend, and she kept calling him. The cellphone was locked and I never got access to it. The notifications were all displayed on the lock screen of the cellphone. Ofc. Cuneo was able to find Shine's girlfriend in the parking lot to Outback and she then walked over to my location. Inside the vehicle on the passenger side, I located Shine's wallet, which contained his FL DL, US currency, a FL Medicinal Marijuana Card and other miscellaneous items. In the center console, I located a marijuana blunt (FTP Marijuana, weighted 3.0gm), a vape pen with an oil residue inside (FTP THC), and a glass container with marijuana residue inside of it (FTP Marijuana). Ofc Cuneo field tested the drugs and later packaged them as evidence.

Several officers tried different locations where Shine could have been at but were unable to find him. I completed a tow slip for the vehicle and Arnold's towing transported the vehicle to their tow yard. I collected Shine's wallet and cellphone which were later placed into the KWPD property room for safekeeping. My BWC and my in-car camera videos were later uploaded to the server as evidence.

On July 17th, 2019, I met with SAO reference a warrant for this case. SAO advised they needed further information in Shine's medical marijuana card and needed to subpoena some records. SAO said they would advise me once they receive the information they need so I can proceed with the warrant.

There is no further information at the time of this report.

On 07/16/2019 at 2112 hours I, Ofc. Cuneo responded to 3200 N Roosevelt Blvd. in reference to Ofc. Valdes who was involved in a foot pursuit, involving a traffic stop.

By the time I arrived on scene, the subject was not in custody and a canvass of the area was underway. I met with Ofc. Dantu, who informed me Ofc. Valdez had lost sight of a black male subject near the area of Sears and TJ Max. I began to canvass the area.

As I was searching for the male, I observed a white female on the phone near Sears. I heard on the radio earlier, the male who ran from Ofc. Valdes had left his phone in the vehicle. The female continued to call, and it appeared when no one answered the phone, she would call right back. When I observed the female call again, I radioed to Ofc. Valdes and asked him if the suspects phone was ringing. Ofc. Valdes replied, "No" but soon stated the suspects phone began to ring. I then made contact with the female, as I believed she was involved. The female was later identified as Erica Palomino.

I stopped and asked for her identification and she told me she did not have it and had just been released from jail one days prior. I asked Palomino who she was calling, and she stated, "My boyfriend". I asked what his name was, and Palomino stated, "Derek". I stated, "Derek what?" and she said, "Shine". I then radioed to Ofc. Valdes the suspects name. Palomino stated she did not know where he was. I advised Palomino, Derek's phone was in the car and she stated the car was not in the parking lot. It shall be noted that I am familiar with Derek Shine as I have had previous dealings with him. Derek Shine is a black male.

I attempted to find out if Palomino knew where Derek was, and she did not know. Other information was obtained to find out his whereabouts. Palomino told me Derek, his cousin (Janessa Collins) and her (Palomino) were out at dinner (Outback Steakhouse) when Derek left the restaurant and that was the last time, she saw him. Palomino stated Derek was supposed to pay the diner tab. Palomino stated her wallet was in the car. Not being able to contact Derek, Palomino walked outside and attempted to call Derek. This was when I observed Palomino and made contact with her.

I then obtained all pertinent information and Palomino asked if she could get her wallet out of the vehicle. I then radioed to Ofc. Valdes and asked if Palomino could obtain her belongings. Ofc. Valdes stated it was good for her to do so. I then told Palomino where she could go to get her things.

I drove to where Ofc. Valdes was located (opposite side of Sears). I assisted him in securing of the vehicle. I then spoke with Ofc. Valdes and he informed me he had suspected marijuana. I took possession of a glass pipe, covered in a green leafy substance, and a vape pen with a dark residue inside. Based on my training and experience, I believed this
