A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS CITY PROPERTY KNOWN AS TWO DECOMMISSIONED FIRE TRUCKS, (ONE 1997 FORD F477 FIRETRUCK WITH VIN NUMBER 1FDLF47F1VEA78581 AND ONE 2000 PIERCE DASH FIRE PUMPER VIN NUMBER 4P1CT02XXYA000731) AS DONATIONS TO GREEN TURTLE CAY AND ABACO ISLAND, BAHAMAS PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-771(3)(c) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY PAPERWORK FOR PURPOSES OF THIS PROJECT; PROVIDING A CONDITION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO ACCOMPLISH THE PURPOSE OF THIS PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Hurricane Dorian destroyed much of the public safety equipment on Green Turtle Cay and Abaco Island. The City of Key West has two surplus fire trucks, which could provide essential fire protection for those islands in their time of need; and

WHEREAS, the local non-profit organization, Key West Cares, has volunteered to transport such surplus fire trucks/equipment to designated Bahamas locations at no cost to the City government; and

WHEREAS, the surplus fire trucks have passed their usefulness to the City and the City Commission finds that it would be beneficial to donate the vehicles to governmental organizations in the storm-ravaged Bahamas for public benefit purposes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the disposal of two decommissioned and surplus fire trucks (a 1997 Ford F477 Firetruck with VIN Number 1FDLF47F1VEA78581 and a 2000 Pierce Dash Fire Pumper VIN Number 4P1CT02XXYA000731) is hereby authorized, pursuant to section 2-771(3)(c) of the code of ordinances, by donating one equipment/vehicle for use on Green Turtle Cay, and one vehicle/equipment for use on Abaco Island, Bahamas.

Section 2: That the City shall not incur costs with the transfer to the Bahamas, as the non-profit organization Key West Cares has agreed to transport the vehicles to their destinations.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents for the purposes of this project.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
