

WHEREAS, On September 1, 2019, Cat 5 Hurricane Dorian decimated Green Turtle Cay, Key West's Sister City, and the Abaco Islands, causing catastrophic damage. Many lost their lives, most others lost everything, and the recovery is expected to take years; and

WHEREAS, In response to the magnitude of this loss, community leaders and citizens, Key West City officials, church leaders, and concerned parties partnered with a non-profit to provide emergency and ongoing aid to Green Turtle Cay, New Plymouth, and other Bahamian islands in need; and

**Key West Cares" is working with multiple agencies including governmental, civil and private entities to coordinate relief efforts and, as of September 16th, 2019, has shipped approximately 20,000 pounds of relief cargo to the Bahamas on seven (7) separate flights.
