On Wednesday, September 25, 2019 at approximately 0151 hours, I (Ofc. Arguello) was on patrol heading South on White Street when I noticed a red Lexus coupe (bearing Florida tag HUFN64) swerving twice onto the bike patch in front of me.

The Lexus turned onto Atlantic Boulevard heading East. I was directly behind the Lexus when it swerved off the road to the right side almost striking several plastic barriers. I conducted a traffic stop at 1500 Atlantic Boulevard (Key West Beach Club). I introduced myself to the driver (later identified as Veronika Fenkina, DOB 1/12/92). I informed Fenkina that I pulled her over because she was swerving all over the road and almost hit several plastic barriers. I asked Fenkina where she was coming from, she stated that she was coming from her house. I could smell a strong odor of alcohol coming from Fenkina's breath, she had slurred speech and had glassy eyes. I asked Fenkina for her driver license, registration and proof of insurance. Fenkina handed me her driver license. I asked Fenkina for her registration and she displayed her insurance information from her phone. I asked Fenkina for her registration and she continued to show me her insurance information. After several more attempts in trying to get Fenkina to show me her registration, I told her to continue to look for it while I went back to my patrol car.

Due to the evidence and direct observation I asked Fenkina if she was willing to participate on Field Sobriety Exercises to make sure that she was not impaired, and she agreed to do them.

1) Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus-I explained the exercises to Fenkina. Fenkina understood the instructions. Fenkina was able to follow the stimulus, her eyes tracked equally, and had equal pupil size. During the exercise I observed four clues. Fenkina had lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes and had distinct, sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation on both eyes.

2) Walk and turn-I attempted to explain the exercise to Fenkina but she would start speaking over me. I tried to explain them three separate times and she continued to interrupt me. Ofc. Hudson explained the instruction to Fenkina, Fenkina told Ofc. Hudson that she understood the instructions, Fenkina left the starting postion more than one time. I observed Fenkina beginning the exercises before being told to start. Fenkina took eleven steps. Fenkina did not complete the second set of nine step by taking zero steps.

3) One leg stand- Ofc. Hudson explained the exercise. Fenkina stated that she understood the instructions. Fenkina used her arms to balance herself. Fenkina lifted her left foot. Fenkina did not count out loud and did not kept her eyes on her feet as instructed.

I placed Fenkina under arrest for driving under the influence. I handcuffed Fenkina and placed her in the back of my patrol car. While transporting Fenkina to the Monroe County Detention Center she began kicking the back window of my patrol car and the middle divider. I stopped at the intersection of Josephine Street and Atlantic Boulevard to place a hobble on Fenkina's ankles, so she would not break the side window or the divider. While driving to the jail Fenkina told me that she was going to pay someone to kill me, that I was going to regret doing this to her and that I was a "Piece of shit".

Upon arrival, we took Fenkina out of my patrol car. Fenkina told Ofc. Hudson if he wanted her to kick him. While Ofc. Hudson was escorting Fenkina to the sallyport slider, she lunged towards Ofc. Hudson and made contact around his chest area, knocking off his BWC. While waiting for the Detention Deputies to open the door, I witnessed Fenkina kicking backwards towards Ofc. Hudson, making contact in his right and left shins. We ordered Fenkina to stop resisting, she attempted to spit at Ofc. Hudson in the face, but Ofc. Hudson informed me that saliva did not come out from her mouth. While inside the intake area Fenkina attempted to spit at Ofc. Hudson in the face but saliva did not come out from her mouth again.

The Detention Deputies placed Fenkina in the restraint chair due to her behavior. A breath test was not attempted due to the combative behavior of Fenkina. This incident was recorded on my BWC.

Based on the facts, evidence and my direct observations there is probable cause to believe on 9/25/19 at about 0151 hours Fenkina did actually and intentionally kick Ofc. Hudson on his shins while wearing his full law enforcement uniform and performing his duties which violates F.S.S 784.07-2B.

Based on the facts, evidence and my direct observations there is probable cause to believe on 9/25/19 at about 0151 hours Fenkina did threaten me (Ofc. Arguello) that she was going to pay someone to kill me while I was in my full law enforcement uniform and transporting her to the Monroe County Detention Center violation Florida State Statute 838.021-3B.

Based on the facts, evidence and my direct observations there is probable cause to believe on 9/25/19 at about 0151 hours Fenkina resisted with violence by kicking Ofc. Hudson in the process of being escorted inside the Detention Center, which is a violation of Florida State Statute 843.01

On 09/25/2019 at approximately 0158, while on routine patrol in the City of Key West, I responded to the 1500 Block of Atlantic Blvd to assist Officer Arguello with a DUI investigation.

On arrival I met with Officer Arguello who told me he stopped the red sedan for failure to maintain single lane. He stated he could smell an odor of alcoholic beverage and believed the driver, who was identified as Veronika Fenkina DOB 01/12/1992, to be possibly impaired.

Officer Arguello then began Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises. During the exercises, Fenkina was talking over Officer Arguello as he was giving her instructions. During the Walk and Turn exercise Fenkina began to dance and would not comply with Officer Arguello. In effort to afford Fenkina the opportunity to dispel Officer Arguello's suspicion, I assisted with the Walk and Turn and One Leg Stand exercises. They are as follows:

2) Walk and Turn: I explained the exercise to Fenkina. Fenkina understood the instructions. Fenkina was swaying and unable to keep her balance during the instruction phase. Fenkina did leave the starting position more than one time. During the exercise I observed five clues. I did demonstrate the exercise for her before she began. Fenkina did began the exercise before she was told to. On the First Set of Nine, Fenkina took 11 steps. Fenkina did not complete the Second Set of Nine by taking 0 steps. It should be noted, it was a level surface and clear of any debris. I used a fixed white roadway line. Fenkina wore closed toed sneakers for the exercise.

3) One Leg Stand: I explained the exercise to Fenkina. Fenkina understood the instructions. During the exercise I observed one clue; using arms for balance. Fenkina lifted her left foot. Fenkina did not count out loud or keep her eyes on her feet as instructed.

Officer Arguello then placed Fenkina under arrest for DUI.

Officer Arguello then began transport to the Monroe County Detention Center. While on the 1800 Block of Atlantic Blvd, Officer Arguello called out over his KWPD communications channel one Fenkina was kicking the window of his vehicle. The transport was stopped and I assisted Officer Arguello by placing a Hobble restraint device on Fenkina's ankles and secured it in the vehicle. Officer Arguello resumed transport, I followed.

On arrival at the Monroe County Detention Center, once in the Sally Port, I moved the Hobble restraint device just above Fenkina's knees and asked her to step out of the vehicle. As I walked Fenkina (holding her right arm just above her elbow) to the intake door she stopped, kicked in a backward motion at me, turned toward me and lunged at me making contact with my chest knocking my bodycam off my uniform. Fenkina then began to run toward the intake door

while still in my actual control. At this time Fenkina and I both went to the ground.

Officer Arguello and I lifted Fenkina to her feet and walked her to the intake door. Fenkina began to spit at me and again kicked backwards this time making contact with my left and right shins.

The jail Deputies responded and placed Fenkina in a restraint chair.

A breath test was not attempted due to the combative nature of Fenkina.

It should be noted, I am a certified breath test operator in the State of Florida and do possess a valid, in date, permit to administer such test. The instrument used is the Intoxilyzer 8000 S/N 80-007167.

All of the above was captured on my bodyworn camera, 3940.
