On 09/27/2019 at approximately 0313 hours, I, Officer Purcell, observed a group of people standing around a car at the corner of Olivia St and Simonton St and heard a male voice yelling in a loud aggressive voice.

I exited my patrol car and observed the yelling was coming from a Hispanic male later identified as Ricardo Rivera. I approached the vehicle and asked Rivera to come speak to me by my patrol car. Rivera yelled at me "we`re good". I asked Rivera again to come speak to me by my patrol car. Rivera walked with me to my patrol car.

I asked Rivera what was going on. Rivera appeared to calm down and told me he was just in an argument with his girlfriend Tarah Cohen because they didn't see eye to eye on an issue. I asked Rivera if he could provide me with his ID. Rivera said "what" as if he didn't understand what I was asking him for. I asked Rivera again for his ID. Rivera again said "what". I Asked Rivera for his driver's license. Rivera asked me why I needed it. I informed Rivera he was being detained for and investigation and I needed his ID. I explained to Rivera that he was being detained because I did not know why he was aggressively yelling and I was investigating the issue. Cohen and a white male that had been with Rivera approached us and began to speak to me and Rivera. I instructed the male and Cohen to step back and wait by their car. Cohen complied and went back to the vehicle. The male refused. I informed the male that if he did not step back he would be arrested for obstruction. The male stepped back.

I continued to ask Rivera for his ID several more times and he continued to refuse becoming more agitated. I informed Rivera that failure to provide me with his identification was considered obstruction and he could be arrested for it. Rivera replied that was fine with him and he could take an arrest. I asked Rivera again for his driver's license. Rivera became loud and began to wave his hands while telling me this was the reason kids were shooting up schools.

I instructed Rivera to put his hands behind his back. Rivera began to pull away from me. I grabbed Rivera's right arm and attempted to turn him around. Rivera continued to try and pull away from me while turning to face me. I pulled my Taser out of its holster and removed the cartage from it then pressed it against Rivera's torso. I informed Rivera that he was going to be tasered and to put his hands behind his back. Rivera complied and turned around placing his hands behind his back. I placed my Taser back in its holster and put Rivera in handcuffs.

I lead Rivera around the side of my patrol car and the white male and Cohen approached me again. I instructed Cohen and the male to go back and wait by their car. The male and Cohen sat down by my patrol car. I again instructed them to go and wait by their vehicle. Cohen stated she did not need to wait by her car and was staying where she was. The white male also stayed where he was. I requested a seconded unit through via my radio. I instructed Rivera to sit down on the curb. Rivera refused to sit down. I instructed Rivera again to sit on the curb. Rivera did not sit down. I forced Rivera into a seated position on the curb. Rivera began to yell about being forced to sit down.

The white male stood up and approached me. I instructed him to wait by the car. The male stated he was not in violation of any laws. I informed the male he could be arrested for obstruction and told him to wait by the car. The male did not go back to their vehicle but returned to sit next to Cohen. Rivera continued to yell, and Cohen began to try and talk to Rivera. I instructed Cohen to wait by their car. Cohen replied that she would wait right where she was. I informed Cohen that I did not want them right by me because they were aggravating the situation. Cohen refused to move.

I instructed Rivera to stand up and assisted him in doing so. I instructed Rivera to lean against my patrol vehicle.

Rivera began to push back into me refusing to lean against my patrol car. I forced Rivera to lean against my patrol car in order to search him before placing him in the car.

Officer Haynie arrived on scene. Rivera began to yell again and push back against me. Officer Haynie assisted me in holding Rivera against my patrol car while we searched him. I finished searching Rivera and instructed him to get into my patrol car. Rivera pushed back against Officer Haynie and myself refusing to get into the patrol car. Officer Haynie and I took out our Tasers and told Rivera he was going to be tasered and to get into the car. Rivera continued to refuse to get into the patrol vehicle. Officer Haynie and myself utilized our Tasers to drive stun Rivera's torso forcing him into the patrol car. Officer Haynie notified dispatch that our Tasers had been used.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause, that on 9/27/2019, Ricardo Rivera did knowingly and intentionally resist an officer in the legal execution of his duty, in violation of FSS 843.02.

Sgt. Siracuse arrived on scene and spoke with me and then Rivera.

I transported Rivera to the Monroe County Detention Center without further incident.

This investigation was recorded with my Axon BWC.

On Friday, September 27, 2019 at 3:15 AM, I was dispatched to back Officer Purcell who was dealing with a verbal disturbance at Simonton Street and Olivia Street. Key West Communications suggested I expedite as they believed the situation was escalating and Officer Purcell's radio had switched channels.

I activated my lights and sirens, responding priority one.

I arrived on scene and observed Officer Purcell holding a male subject, Ricardo Rivera, against the back-passenger's side of his car. Ricardo was in handcuffs. Ricardo was shouting and his body was tensed up. After checking Ricardo's person, incident to arrest, we began to move him toward the back seat of the car. Ricardo ignored our verbal commands to get into the back seat of Officer Purcell's patrol vehicle. Ricardo tensed his body, preventing us from being able to maneuver him into the seat. Officer Purcell and I both pulled our tasers, removed the cartridges, and drive-stunned Ricardo in his right torso. Ricardo's body reacted by bending which enabled us to get him in the back seat successfully.

I advised over Key West Communications Channel One we drive-stunned a subject.

I stood by while Officer Purcell finished his investigation and while Sergeant Siracuse arrived and conducted a Response to Resistance investigation.

I activated my KWPD issued bodycam during this call.
