On September 29th, 2019, I (Ofc. G Kouri), was dispatched to Havana Cabana (3420 North Roosevelt Blvd, Key West, FL), in reference to a male subject refusing to leave.

Upon arrival, I was approached by the Supervisor of the hotel (John Alexander). Alexander stated there is a male subject inside of the hotel lobby who is refusing to leave and says he is in "The place of God". Alexander stated he has been there for the last two hours and will not leave. The hotel staff also stated he was pacing around the lobby area and the upstairs area of the hotel. Ofc. Grassi and I walked into the lobby and Alexander pointed to the male. The male was a white male sitting in a wooden rocking chair reading what looked like a bible.

I approached the male subject and introduced myself as an Officer with the Key West Police Department. I explained to the subject that he is on private property and has been asked to leave. The subject replied, "This is Gods house". I asked the subject what his name is, and he told me "David Christ". I explained to the subject that he needed to leave the property, or he would be arrested for trespassing. The male subject continued to refuse to leave and would not look up from his bible to have a conversation with us. I keyed up on our main police channel and asked for one more officer to head my way as he is refusing to leave, and we were more than likely going to need to physically remove him. I explained to the subject that he has one more chance to get up and leave or he would be leaving with us and placed under arrest.

Sgt. Blasberg, Ofc. T Mitchell and Ofc. Keohane arrived on scene. Sgt Blasberg asked the subject to leave and he refused. Sgt. Blasberg placed his hand on the subjects' shoulder to get his attention and the subject told Sgt. Blasberg to not touch him. After several attempts to ask the subject to leave, Sgt. Blasberg grabbed the bible out of the subject's hands. The subject began to immediately tense up and would not comply with verbal commands to put his hands behind his back. Sgt. Blasberg and Ofc. Grassi grabbed the subjects' right arm and I grabbed his left arm. The subject would not follow verbal commands to stop tensing or to put his hands behind his back. The subject kept saying "okay", however, he would not stop physically tensing and pulling. The subject kneeled on the ground from his sitting position and at that point Ofc. Grassi had his left arm, Sgt. Blasberg had his right arm and Ofc T Mitchell and I were holding his legs down from kicking us. We were all on the ground still attempting to get the subject handcuffed and the subject tried to get up. Ofc. Keohane drive stunned the subject with her Taser. The subject continued to tense his arms however, he was eventually hand cuffed.

The subject was placed into the back seat of my marked patrol vehicle. I transported the subject to Monroe County Detention Center. Monroe County Deputies met me in the Sally Port at the jail and escorted the subject upstairs to begin the intaking process. While at the jail, Ofc. Keohane sent me a photo of the subjects Wisconsin Identification card. The subject is identified as Steven Allen Waychoff (DOB: 05/24/1984).

My body camera was activated during this incident.

Waychoff was placed under arrest for Trespassing FSS. 810.09, Resisting Officer without Violence FSS. 843. 02 and Giving False name to LEO FSS. 901. 36.

On 09/29/2019, at 1450 hours, I (Ofc. T. Mitchell) responded to 3420 North Roosevelt Boulevard (Havana Cabana) in reference to a trespasser in the lobby.

Ofc. G. Kouri and Ofc. J. Grassi responded initially, and advised over the radio that they needed additional officers to respond due to the subject (Steven Allen Waychoff, DOB 05/28/1984) refusing to comply with their orders to leave the property.

Sgt. F. Blasberg also responded.

Upon my arrival (Ofc. K. Keohane arrived shortly after), Waychoff was sitting in a chair located on the left side of the lobby when you enter the front door, and facing a large floor to ceiling window. Waychoff had an open Bible in his lap, and Sgt. F. Blasberg was explaining that he needed to vacate the property. Waychoff refused to comply and kept making biblical references about us feeling the wrath of God and burning in flames. Waychoff refused to comply with Sgt. F. Blasberg's lawful orders to place his hands behind his back. Sgt. F. Blasberg and Ofc. G. Kouri grabbed hold of each of Waychoff's wrists in an attempt to place his hands behind his back (while still seated in the chair). Waychoff began to tense his body and pull his arms in towards his body. I was standing behind Waychoff and began to apply pressure to the pressure point under Waychoff's jaw, while he continued to be instructed to place his hands behind his back. Waychoff still did not comply, and continued to tense and pull his arms in towards his body. Ofc. G. Kouri was unable to get his left arm behind his back, due to his seated position. I pushed Waychoff forward (bending forward at the waist to allow the arm to come back) and Sgt. F. Blasberg directed Waychoff in an "arm bar" takedown towards the ground, from a seated position.

As he did so, Waychoff slid out of the chair and onto the ground, with his knees tucked under him and his left arm tucked under his chest. Ofc. K. Keohane delivered a "drive stun" (Probeless/cartridgeless, pain compliance only) to the upper portion of Waychoff's back in an effort to get his left arm out from under him and behind his back. Waychoff then complied and Ofc. J. Grassi was able to get his left hand behind his back. Ofc. G. Kouri and I controlled Waychoff's legs (he was kicking and trying to ball up), while I placed him in handcuffs.

Waychoff was placed in Ofc. G. Kouri's patrol vehicle and transported to the Monroe County Detention Center.

My body worn camera got knocked off during the incident. I uploaded the video to AXON.

There is nothing further.

On today's date, Ofc. G. Kouri was dispatched to 3420 N. Roosevelt Blvd. regarding a trespasser. After arriving, Ofc. G. Kouri requested another unit and advised over COMM 1 the subject was probably going to not comply. I advised I'd would also be headed to the call.

At the scene, I saw a W/M seated in a chair in the front of the lobby. I activated my BWC and walked over to him. I introduced myself and which police department I was with (wearing my class B uniform which is easily recognizable as a police officer) and told the W/M (later identified as WAYCHOFF) why I/we were there. WAYCHOFF said basically he did not care why we were there and he was going to stay there and read his Bible. I tried to persuade WAYCHOFF to leave the hotel and even asked him if there was anything I could do or say to get him to leave. Again WAYCHOFF said he wasn't leaving and there was nothing I could do.

At this point, WAYCHOFF had been asked by hotel staff, other officers and finally myself to leave which he refused. Since WAYCHOFF refused these requests to leave, WAYCHOFF was now trespassing after warning.

As we attempted to take WAYCHOFF into custody, he began to resist. WAYCHOFF began to tense his arms, legs and torso in an attempt to thwart our endeavors to handcuff him. I applied a wrist/arm bar to his right hand/arm which was successful but the left arm was free and not under control. In the scuffle, WAYCHOFF was taken to the ground in a controlled manner (from a seated position) but his left arm/hand still was free. Once on the ground, WAYCHOFF began to tuck his free hand/arm underneath and that is when Ofc. Keohane applied a drive stun from her departmental issued TASER. WAYCHOFF immediately complied, bringing his free hand out from underneath and we were able to finally handcuff him without any further resistance.

WAYCHOFF had no visible injuries nor did he complain of any injuries sustained during the scuffle. WAYCHOFF was taken to MCDC and was remanded to their custody.

On September 29, 2019, at about 1437 hours, I (Officer Grassi) responded as backup to Havana Cabana, 3420 North Roosevelt Boulevard, regarding a trespasser.

Upon arrival, I spoke with a manager of the property, with Officer Kouri. The manager told Officer Kouri and I there was a white male (identified as Steven Waychoff) who he had told several times to leave and he refused. The manager advised Waychoff was not a guest at Havana Cabana.

I saw Waychoff sitting in the front lobby in a chair, reading the bible. I saw Waychoff had his car keys sitting on a table next to him. Officer Kouri and I spoke with Waychoff. Waychoff said he would not leave the property because he was in God's Land and didn't have to. Officer Kouri and I explained to Waychoff he had to leave the property. Waychoff continued to not comply and said he would not leave. Waychoff would not tell us his correct name and eventually stopped responding to us entirely.

Officer Kouri requested another unit respond as backup. Sergeant Blasberg, Officer Mitchell and Officer Keohane all responded as backup to Havana Cabana.

Waychoff continued to not comply. Waychoff tensed his arms and would not put his hands behind his back. I assisted Sergeant Blasberg and Officer Mitchell with handcuffing Waychoff by keeping control of his arm. I helped searched Waychoff, but I did not find anything in his pockets.

Officer Keohane located Waychoff's vehicle in the back of the property, with the keys he had with him. Officer Keohane requested a wrecker to tow Waychoff's vehicle. I completed a tow slip for Waychoff's vehicle.

My agency AXON body worn camera was activated during the incident and was submitted into Key West Police Department Property and Evidence.

On Sunday, September 29, 2019, at approximately 14:30 hours, I responded to 3420 North Roosevelt Blvd, in reference to trespasser. Ofc. G. Kouri arrived on scene and requested other officers respond as the subject was not complying with her.

Ofc. T. Mitchell, Ofc. J. Grassi and Sgt. Blasberg arrived before me. When I arrived, I observed Sgt. Blasberg talking to the subject, explaining to him that he needed to comply with his lawful command and leave the hotel quietly. The subject, identified as Steven Waychoff by his Wisconsin ID card, refused to comply.

Waychoff was given several commands and warnings but he refused to comply. Sgt. Blasberg took Waychoff by his right arm to escort him out and Waychoff immediately tensed his whole body, refusing to move. Waychoff was then guided to the ground by Sgt. Blasberg and Ofc. Mitchell. Waychoff was on his stomach when he was put down and he immediately put his left arm under his body. He was given several commands to bring his arm to his back, but he refused to comply. I had my tazer out and Waychoff was aware of this. I told him that he would be tazed if he refused to comply. When he refused to put his left arm towards his back, I delivered an approximate 2-3 second dive stun to his left shoulder. Waychoff then brought his arm to his back and began to cooperate with officers.

Waychoff was taken to jail by Ofc. G. Kouri. There were no reported injuries at the time the incident occurred.

Waychoff's vehicle was found parked in the rear parking lot of 3420 North Roosevelt Blvd. It appeared he had been sleeping in it, as there was a small mattress in the back. The vehicle was towed from the property by Arnolds Towing. The incident was recorded on my BWC. Both the BWC and the Tazer cam were downloaded.
