On 9/30/2019, at about 0056 hrs, I (Ofc. Dantu) was at a crash scene on the corner of Duval Street and Southard Street when I received a call over the radio for assistance from Ofc. Dehanas.

Ofc. Dehanas was inside of Willie T's at 535 Duval Street. Upon arrival, I met with Ofc. Dehanas. Ofc. Dehanas was speaking to a male person, (Lawrence Kennard). Kennard was lying on the floor and bleeding from a cut on his nose. Kennard had a strong odor of alcohol coming from his breath and Kennard's eyes were blood shot.

Management at Willie T's wanted Kennard off of their property. Kennard was refusing to stand up and leave. Ofc. Dehanas had called for Rescue to attend to Kennard. Kennard was unwilling to cooperate with Rescue when they attempted to attend to him. Kennard refused to leave the property.

Ofc. Dehanas and I managed to help Kennard to his feet and assist him out of Willie T's and onto the side walk.

Rescue attempted to attend to Kennard once again. Kennard once again did not cooperate with Rescue and refused help.

Ofc. Dehanas confirmed Kennard's ID with KWPD Dispatch. Kennard did not have any outstanding warrants. I told Kennard he was free to go. Kennard refused to leave and began to harass people walking past Willie T's. (Kennard began showing his middle finger to people walking past Willie T's. Kennard began to verbally abuse people walking past Willie T's.)

I asked Kennard to leave multiple times. Kennard did not leave. I decided that Kennard needed to be Marchman Acted for his own safety.

Ofc. Dehanas left the scene to get his vehicle. (Ofc. Dehanas was going to Marchman Act Kennard and transport him to Monroe County Detention Center).

I attempted to handcuff Kennard. I placed one handcuff on Kennard's right wrist. I tried to handcuff Kennard's left wrist but Kennard began to resist. I told Kennard to stop resisting. Kennard continued to resist and attempt to break his hands free from my grip.

Kennard began to tense his entire body and attempted to turn around and face me. (Kennard was facing away from me when I attempted to handcuff him.) I managed to move Kennard up against the Rescue Vehicle in an attempt to stop Kennard from turning around and facing me. (I did not want Kennard to break free from my grip on his right hand for fear of Kennard using the handcuffs as a weapon).

I managed to call for back up over the radio. Ofc. Dehanas arrived on scene. Ofc. Dehanas attempted to control Kennard's left wrist. I was holding Kennard's right wrist and attempting to handcuff Kennard's left wrist when he positioned himself sideways and faced me. Kennard looked at me, moved his neck and head back and shoved it forward ramming his forehead into my left cheek bone below my left eye.

At this point I decided to take Kennard to the ground. I let go of his wrist, placed my arms around his shoulders and moved him to the ground. Once Kennard was on the ground he stopped resisting. (taking Kennard to the ground was an instant reaction from being head butted by Kennard).

Rescue attended to Kennard. Kennard had a cut on his head. Kennard was transported to Lower Keys Medical Center. Ofc. Dehanas accompanied Kennard to Lower Keys Medical Center with Rescue.

I had a contusion to my left cheek bone and blood transfer on my face from Kennard splitting the area above his eye when he rammed his forehead into my cheek bone.

Sgt. Siracuse arrived on scene. Ofc. Tellier and Ofc. Jackson arrived on scene. Sgt. Siracuse and Ofc. Tellier photographed my left cheek bone.

I completed my crash Investigation.

Once I completed my crash investigation I met Ofc. Dehanas at Monroe County Detention Center. Ofc. Dehanas told me Kennard became violent at Lower Keys Medical Center. Kennard kicked Ofc. Dehanas in the chin as Ofc. Dehanas walked by the hospital bed that Kennard in. Kennard had to be restrained at Lower Keys Medical Center. (See Ofc. Dehanas's supplemental).

Kennard was released by Lower Keys Medical Center and transported by Ofc. Dehanas to Monroe County Detention Center. Kennard had to be restrained at Monroe County Detention Center.

A glass smoking pipe, wrapping papers and a green leafy substance was found by deputy Brady in the front pocket of Kennard's backpack.

Ofc. Dehanas tested the brown leafy substance. The brown leafy substance tested positive for marijuana. The brown leafy substance was weighed by Ofc. Dehanas. 1st weight was 2.4 grams and the 2nd weight was 17.5 grams.

Based on the facts and evidence in this case there is probable cause to believe on 9/30/2019, at about 0040 hrs and at about 0110 hrs two batteries on separate law enforcement officers were committed by Kennard. There is probable cause to believe on 9/30/2019, at about 0040 hrs and 0110 hrs Kennard did actually and intentionally touch or strike a police officer / law enforcement officer against his or her will or cause bodily harm; Kennard knew that the alleged victim was a law enforcement officer / police officer; and the law enforcement or police officer was engaged in the lawful performance of his or her duties when Kennard committed the battery. (According to Section 784.07, Florida Statutes).

Based on the facts and evidence in this case there is probable cause to believe on 9/30/2019, at about 0040 hrs resisted an officer with violence. resisted, obstructed, or opposed a law enforcement officer; At the time, the officer was engaged in the execution of a legal duty; The officer was a person legally authorized to execute process; and At the time, Kennard knew that the person resisted, obstructed, or opposed was in fact an officer or other person legally authorized to execute process. (According to Section 843.02, Florida Statutes).

Based on the facts and evidence in this case there is probable cause to believe on 9/30/2019, at about 0130 hrs, Kennard possessed less than 20 grams of marijuana. Kennard possessed a certain substance, (actual or constructive); the substance was cannabis (less than 20 grams); and Kennard had knowledge of the presence of the substance.

I arrested Kennard for Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer (x 2) - 784.07 Florida Statutes

The subject started to get up and Ofc. Dehanas directed him to sit back. Ofc. Dehanas was standing next to his bedside. The subject had his legs up on the bed and then lunged his back down, and kicked his legs up kicking Ofc. Dehanas in his face. I ran over and grabbed his legs and pushed them down and restrained his legs by putting my knee across his legs holding them down. Ofc. Jackson got a hobble strap and we restrained his legs down.

Lower Keys Medical Center staff cleared the subject and he was transported to the Monroe County Correctional Center by Ofc. Dehanas.

This ends my involvement in the case.

On 09/30/19, at approximately 2333hrs, I (Ofc. B. DeHanas) was flagged down by an employee of Willie T's Bar (525 Duval Street).

Willie T's staff told me that Lawrence William Kennard was inside the bar and passed out. Willie T's staff told me they wanted Lawrence removed from the property.

I noticed that Lawrence had a laceration on his nose. I requested rescue services to respond to evaluate Lawrence and his condition. Rescue responded to the scene and evaluated Lawrence. I also requested Ofc. N. Dantu to respond as backup. After rescue evaluated Lawrence, I determined that Lawrence would need to be taken into protective custody under the Marchman Act. Lawrence could barely stand, and it was very difficult to hold a conversation with him due to his slurred speech.

Ofc. N. Dantu asked me to get my patrol car and bring it around to the front of Willie T's. When I returned with my patrol car, I could see that Ofc. N. Dantu was struggling with Lawrence by trying to handcuff him. I quickly parked my patrol car and ran over to assist Ofc. N. Dantu. Once with Ofc. N. Dantu, I handcuffed Lawrence. Ofc. N. Dantu and myself escorted Lawrence to the rear of my patrol car. While I was searching Lawrence, I saw him turn and move his head toward Ofc. N. Dantu, like he was going to headbutt him. From my point of view, I did not see Lawrence actually headbutt Ofc. N. Dantu. Ofc. N. Dantu then brought Lawrence to the ground with my assistance. Lawrence had a laceration to the back of his head from being brought to the ground. Rescue evaluated Lawrence. I requested that Sgt. M. Siracuse respond.

I rode onboard with rescue while they transported Lawrence to the emergency room. While at the emergency room, I went to make Lawrence lay back in the hospital bed. Once I began to walk away from Lawrence, he kicked my face, making contact with my chin. I held pressure on Lawrence's face and chest with the assistance of Ofc. N. Mogerly and Ofc. A. Gillespie. I transported Lawrence to the Monroe County Detention Center once he was medically cleared.

While at the Monroe County Detention Center, Deputy Brady told me he located some marijuana (which later field tested positive for marijuana), a smoking pipe and wrapping papers in a front pocket of Lawrence's book bag. I took the items and submitted them to the Property and Evidence Section of the Key West Police Department.
