A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING TASK ORDER 1-20-ENGINEERING FOR CH2M HILL, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$243,312.00 FOR DESIGN SERVICES FOR PAVEMENT AND RIGHT OF WAY IMPROVEMENTS TO WHITEHEAD, DUVAL AND FRONT STREETS; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 17-207, the City Commission approved a contract with CH2M Hill, Inc. for General Engineering Services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Task Order No. 1-20-Engineering from CH2M Hill Engineering, Inc. for Design of Pavement and Right of Way Improvements to Whitehead, Duval and Front Streets is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$243,312.00.

Section 2: That this project is budgeted in account 102-4102-541-6300 Project Code II41021902 (Internal Improvements/Streets). It is anticipated that FCAA and Monroe County will share costs for each entity's proportional share of the project design, and accordingly necessary budget adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
