A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING CAVALLO EQUESTRIAN ART, LLC TO CONDUCT A "FAMILY STYLE HORSE SHOW UNDER THE BIG TOP TENT" AT THE TRUMAN WATERFRONT GREEN SPACE, ACROSS FROM THE AMPHITHEATER ON FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 28TH, SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 29 & SUNDAY, MARCH 1, 2020 FROM 3:00 P.M. TO 8:00 P.M; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Cavallo Equestrian Art, LLC, has applied to the City for a Special Event Permit for a Family Style Horse Show under the Big Top Tent on Friday, February 28, Saturday, February 29 and March 1, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West Florida;

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City

Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public

property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship

with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless
such use is otherwise preempted by law"

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City"

SECTION 3. That the Cavallo Equestrian Art, LLC is hereby granted permission to conduct a "Family Style Horse Show" on the day and during the hours stated above;

PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and that organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That Cavallo Equestrian Art, LLC will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
