

920 CORNISH LANE

EASEMENT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this ____ day of _____, 2020,
between the City of Key West, Florida (hereinafter Grantor) and
John P. Huss & David R. Genest as owner of property located at
920 Cornish Lane, Key West, Florida (hereinafter the Grantee)
(RE # 00007670-000000).

I. RECITALS

Grantee is owner of the property known as 920 Cornish Lane,
Key West, Florida, including existing brick pavers, a four-foot
picket fence with a gate, and landscaping that encroaches onto
the Grantor's right-of-way. Portions of Grantee's property
encroach 177 square feet, more or less, onto the Grantor's
right-of-way.

COMMENCE at the intersection of the Northwesterly right of
way line of Southard Street with the Southwesterly right of way
line of Grinnell Street and run thence Northwesterly along the
Southwesterly right of way line of the said Grinnell Street for
a distance of 159.00 feet to the Southeasterly right of way line
of Cornish Lane; thence Southwesterly and at right angles along
the Southeasterly right of way line of the said Cornish Lane for
a distance of 69.00 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence

continue Southwesterly along the previous described course for a distance of 31.00 feet; thence Northwesterly and at right angles for a distance of 5.60 feet; thence Northeasterly with a deflection angle of 89 degrees, 37 feet, 49 inches to the right for a distance of 31.00 feet; thence Southeasterly with a deflection angle of 90 degrees, 22 feet, 11 inches to the right for a distance of 5.80 feet back to the Point of Beginning, containing 177 square feet, more or less as specifically described and illustrated in the attached specific purpose survey dated June 7, 2019 by J. Lynn O'Flynn, PSM of J. Lynn O'Flynn, Inc. (Copy attached hereto). This encroachment impedes marketability of the property.

II. CONVEYANCE OF EASEMENT

The Grantor hereby agrees to grant and convey to the Grantee an easement for encroachments, at the property located at 920 Cornish Lane, as more specifically described in the attached survey. The easement shall pertain to the existing brick pavers, the four-foot picket fence with a gate, and landscaping herein described, and not to any other encroachment. The granting of this easement is conditioned upon the following:

1. Prior to the easement becoming effective, the Grantee shall obtain Personal Liability insurance that extends coverage to the property that is governed by this easement with

limits of no less than \$300,000. Coverage must be provided by an insurer authorized to conduct business in the State of Florida and with terms and conditions consistent with the latest version of the Insurance Service Office's (ISO) latest filed Homeowners or Personal Lines form.

2. The City may unilaterally terminate the easement upon a finding of public purpose by vote of the Key West City Commission.
3. The owner shall pay the annual fee of \$400.00 specified in Code Section 2-938(b) (3).
4. The owner shall irrevocably appoint the City Manager as its agent to permit the removal of the encroachment if the annual fee required by the Code of Ordinances is not paid.
5. The area to maintain the existing brick pavers, the four-foot picket fence with a gate, and landscaping shall be the total allowed construction within the easement area.
6. The easement area shall not be used in site size calculations such as lot, yard, and bulk calculations for site development.
7. The City reserves the right to construct surface improvements within the easement area.
8. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Grantee expressly agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Key West, their respective officers, directors, agents and

employees (herein called the "indemnitees") from all liability for damage.

9. Vehicular parking may not exceed the fence line boundaries.

III. CONSIDERATION

Grantee agrees to pay to Grantor all sums and fees for city sewer, city garbage, if unpaid; otherwise to promptly bring the property and all uses thereof into full compliance with all city and state laws and regulations, if it is not now in full compliance. Grantee further agrees to pay Grantor an annual fee for this easement in the total amount of \$400.00, payable annually on the anniversary date of the execution of this Easement Agreement, to the City of Key West. Failure to pay such annual fee and/or to conform with agreed upon additional conditions shall constitute grounds for the Grantor to terminate the easement.

IV. EASEMENT TERMINATION

Grantee agrees that the improvements located on the Easement shall not be enlarged or expanded.

Grantee shall have the right to repair and maintain the improvements in the ordinary course of maintenance.

The easement shall terminate upon the removal of the existing brick pavers, the four-foot picket fence with a gate, and landscaping.

The Grantor herein expressly and irrevocably appoints the City Manager of the City of Key West as its agent to permit the removal of the encroachment in the event the annual fee referred to hereinabove is not paid.

In the event Grantor determines that retaking this property is necessary for a public purpose by virtue of a vote of the City Commission, then Grantor may unilaterally terminate this easement and reclaim the property without compensation to Grantee.

This easement shall be considered a covenant that runs with the land and shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their heirs, successors and assigns.
