- Water Supply Plan Update: Working on adopting Miami Dade County's Water Fixtures Guidelines as an addendum to our Building Code. Draft to Planning Director 2/24.
- Adaptation Planning Team: Next meeting 2/21
 - Last Meeting Recap: 1/20: Discussed methodologies of achieving an "Adaptation Plan" including contracting and FTE. Team encouraged to not set a limit for needed adaptation projects for bonding.
