- Users
 - 80k
- Visits
 - 260k

Footprint in the Florida Keys

- In 2006, CHI was invited by Fisherman's Hospital to provide health care services
- In 2007, CHI opened its Marathon Health Center
- In 2014, CHI opened its Tavernier Health Center
- In 2019, CHI completely renovated its building in Marathon and "reopened" the Marathon Health Center in the new space
- In 2019, CHI purchased a building in Key Largo to renovate and deliver health care services beginning in 2021



Healthcare Need in Key West

- 25,000 estimated residents in Key West.
- 10,310 are considered low-income.
- Health center penetration of the low-income population is 26%.
- 7,641 low-income not served by a health center.
- Health center penetration of the uninsured population is 12%.
- Population ever told have high blood pressure 37%
- Population who are obese 28%
- Population estimated with no dental visit in past year 33%
- Population of adults with no usual source of care 29%



Bahama Village Health Center Proposed Services

- Family medicine
- Pediatrics
- OBGYN
- Dental Services
- Psychiatric Services (via telehealth)
- Pharmacy (via tele-pharmacy)



Bahama Village Health Center Proposed Staffing

- 1 full-time Family Medicine Provider
- 1 full-time Dentist
- 1 part-time Pediatrician (two days per week)
- 1 part-time Obstetrics Physician (two days per week)
- 1 part-time Psychiatrist (two days per week; via telehealth)
- 1 full-time Dental Assistant
- 1 part-time Dental Hygienist (two days per week)
- 2 full-time Front Desk Staff
- 1 full-time Care Coordinator
- 3 full-time Medical Assistants
- 1 full-time Office Manager
- 1 full-time Environmental Worker



Bahama Village Health Center Staff Recruitment

- Strong human resources department capacity
- Participation in FL Keys employment and health fairs
- Academic alliances
- Social media
- Competitive salaries, benefits, improved turnover
- Existing staff interest (dental, nursing & environmental)
