My preliminary results below for my survey of Docks A and C. A-Dock from harbor walk out not including previously repaired fingers. C-dock including fuel pier and around building.

Attached representative photos. A lot of the rusting/swelling hardware has caused cracking in the structural timbers. I included timbers on this list that showed enough damage that the overall deck appears to have settled out of the originally constructed elevation or otherwise appear close to failure.

A dock Bad pile - 11 Each

A dock Cracked Stringer/Joist - 8 Each

A dock Missing Diagonal 1 Each, but additional bracing should be added to A-dock fingers mid span to reduce movement.

C dock Bad Pile – 4 Each C dock Cracked stringer/Joist – 8 Each

This is not a survey of every structural compnent and meant to be representative of the area described.
