A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE AWARD OF SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF UP TO \$159,460.00 UNDER PROVISIONS OF THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT (CARES ACT) TOWARDS HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES FOR PERSONS WITH AIDS (HOPWA) GRANTEES TO MAINTAIN OPERATIONS AND FOR RENTAL ASSISTANCE, SUPPORTIVE SERVICES AND OTHER NECESSARY ACTIONS IN RESPONSE TO THE CORONAVIRUS; AUTHORIZING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OFFICE (CDO) TO SUBMIT NECESSARY DOCUMENTATION WITH THE CITY OF KEY WEST AS "APPLICANT" AND AIDS HELP, INC. (AHI) AS "SPONSOR"; APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE "DESCRIPTIVE BUDGET JUSTIFICATION NARRATIVE" PROVIDED BY THE CDO AND AHI FOR EXISTING HOPWA GRANT #FLH-190020; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS AND ANY SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS THAT MAY INCREASE FUNDING UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, supplemental funding has been made available through the CARES Act to HOPWA program grantees to provide rental assistance, supportive services and other necessary actions in response to the coronavirus pandemic; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That an award of supplemental funding in the amount of up to \$159,460.00 under the CARES Act to maintain

operations, and for the provision of rental assistance, supportive services and other necessary actions in response to the Coronavirus, to supplement HOPWA Grant #FLH190020 as described in the attached letter dated April 2, 2020 from Rita Harcrow, Director, Office of HIV/AIDS Housing for Community Planning and Development, U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development, is hereby approved and accepted.

Section 2: That the attached "Descriptive Budget Justification Narrative" prepared by the CDO and AHI relating to existing HOPWA Grant #FLH-190020 is hereby approved in the amount of \$159,460.00, and is authorized for submission to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, with the City of Key West as "Applicant" and AIDS Help, Inc. as the project "Sponsor".

Section 3: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any necessary documents and subsequent amendments that may result in additional coronavirus funding support on behalf of the City of Key West, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That the City of Key West's Community Development Office is hereby requested to provide technical assistance and liaison on the CARES Act supplemental application(s) for HOPWA support to AIDS Help, Inc. and administer the grant.

Section 5: That the City of Key West's Community Development Office is hereby directed to continue to collect data, monitor, and evaluate the "Sponsor's" project and its program activities on behalf of the "Applicant" and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Section 6: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
