A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE CONFLICT RESOLUTION **PROCEDURES** SECTION 164 FLORIDA STATUTES WITH THE FLORIDA KEYS MOSQUITO CONTROL DISTRICT ("DISTRICT") IN AN EFFORT TO RESOLVE THE OUTSTANDING ISSUE OF THE COST REMEDIATION OF CONTAMINATION DISCOVERED AT THE FORMER MOSQUITO CONTROL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 5224 COLLEGE ROAD; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY STATUTORILY REQUIRED NOTICES AND TO PROCEED AS SET FORTH IN SAID STATUTE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission for the City of Key West, having considered the status of the City's efforts to obtain a commitment by the Florida Keys Mosquito Control District to reimburse the City of Key West for costs incurred in the ecological clean up of the property located at 5224 College Road, which clean up was required due to petroleum and pesticide discharges on the site believed to have been caused by the District, has determined that conflict resolution procedures may be necessary; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission for the City of Key West authorizes the City Manager to initiate the conflict resolution procedures provided for in Section 164 Florida Statutes prior to initiating court proceedings against the Florida Keys Mosquito Control District. No other governmental entities are believed to be required to participate in the proceedings.

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to execute and issue all notices required under the statute to the appropriate officials of the District.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect
immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication
by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of
the Commission.
