KKK members to hold a 'Meet the Klan' day

The Ku Klux Klan plans to hold a "Meet the Klan" day at Bayview Park in Key West on Saturday, the state's Grand

Dragon said Wednesday.

Several Klan members visited Key West in December, handing out white supremacist literature on Duval Street. This time, three members in robes will talk to anyone interested in learning more about the group, said John Baumgardner, state director of the Invisible Empire Knights of the Ku Klux Klan.

The Klan obtained a permit from the city for the meeting,

scheduled for 1 p.m.

"We're starting to get a little bit of a following down there in Key West," Baumgardner said.
