On July 21, 2020, at approximately 1729 hours, I, Ofc. Waite, was dispatched to Shooterz, located at 3102 Flagler Avenue, in reference to a theft. A bartender at Shooterz, identified later as Thomas Andrews, advised a customer stole a patron's cell phone and left the establishment traveling south on foot on Kennedy Drive towards Riviera Street. Andrews described the subject as a white male wearing a black shirt and shorts and was possibly named "Louie Terracina", identified later as Louis Terracina.

On arrival, I searched the area for Terracina but was unable to make contact. At Shooterz I spoke with Andrews who told me Terracina came into the bar and ordered two long island iced teas and a buffalo chicken platter. Andrews said Terracina consumed one of the long island iced teas then walked outside as if he was going to smoke a cigarette. Andrews said one of his patrons, identified later as Michael Burge, was smoking a cigarette outside and spoke with Terracina. When Burge returned to his table, he notified Andrews that his cell phone was missing. When nearby patrons heard Burge, they notified Andrews that Terracina may have taken Burge's phone and told him that Terracina was acting strange and attempted to sell them Percocet and marijuana while inside of the business.

I spoke with Burge, who told me Terracina approached him as he was outside smoking a cigarette. Burge said Terracina also attempted to sell him Percocet and marijuana. Burge told me he declined the offer at which point Terracina stated he was going to walk around the side of the building and urinate. Burge said when he returned inside his cell phone was missing.

Burge described his phone as a waterproof Android. Burge said he purchased the phone approximately 6 months ago from Verizon for \$800.00. Burge was unable to provide a serial number for the phone and could not remember the phone's make or model.

Andrews provided me access to the business' security footage and I witnessed the following. Burge is sitting at a table near the bar drinking a beer. Laying next to Burge's beer is his cell phone. Burge walks away from the bar with his beer leaving his phone on the table. Terracina walks up to the bar and speaks to Andrews. Andrews serves Terracina a beverage then Terracina walks over to Burge's table and takes a seat. Terracina begins talking to Andrews and nearby patrons when he notices the cell phone on the table. Andrews turns his back on Terracina at which point he quickly attempts to conceal the cell phone in a cargo pocket on his right pant leg. Just before Andrews turns back around, Terracina places the phone back on the table. Moments later, Andrews turns his back to Terracina and he quickly places the phone inside of his right pant pocket. Terracina then walks away from the table towards the front door.

Andrews provided me a copy of Terracina's receipt which totaled \$26.20. The receipt was itemized and listed the following: Two long islands iced teas valued at \$18.00 and a buffalo chicken platter valued at \$8.00. Andrews also asked that Terracina be issued trespass a warning from Shooterz, on his behalf, should Officers make contact with him.

After leaving Shooterz, I visited Terracina's home address, 1213 14th Street Lot 120. I made contact with Terracina's father, Louis Terracina Sr. who advised his son was not home. Terracina's father stated his son came by the house, approximately 30 minutes prior to my arrival, and was extremely intoxicated. Terracina's father said his son left but if he returned, he would let me know. At approximately 1930 hours, Terracina's father contacted Key West Communications and advised his son was home. Ofc. Morris and I arrived at the home at approximately 1935 hours and were notified by Terracina's father that his son took off on foot traveling north through the trailer park heading towards Northside Drive. At approximately 2021 hours, Terracina Sr. advised his son was back at the home.

While enroute, Ofc. Morris advised Key West Communications that he made contact with Terracina in front of the home. Shortly after Ofc. Morris stated over the radio that he deployed his taser and had taken Terracina into custody.

On arrival, Terracina was sitting on the ground in handcuffs. Terracina had one taser prong in his left forearm and another one in his left calf. Terracina also had a hematoma on the right side of his head. Sgt. Vazquez requested Rescue reference Terracina's injuries. I spoke to Ofc. Morris who told me the following. Ofc Morris said he approached the house on foot and saw Terracina Sr. standing on the front porch. Terracina exited the home and his father told him that the Police were there and said they wanted to talk to him. Terracina who could now see Ofc. Morris approaching the home, yelled, "what the fuck do you want?" Terracina exited the front porch and started approaching Ofc. Morris. As Terracina had fled from officers earlier in the evening, Ofc. Morris believed Terracina had the apparent ability to flee on foot again. Terracina exited the porch and Ofc. Morris displayed his Taser. Ofc. Morris gave Terracina loud verbal commands to get on the ground. Terracina stopped walking towards Ofc. Morris and turned to go back on to the porch. Terracina stumbled and Ofc. Morris grabbed his left arm with his left hand and escorted him to the ground, in a controlled manner. Ofc. Morris told Terracina to stay seated on the ground and put his hands behind his back. Terracina was sitting on the ground with his hands gripped together. Terracina refused to put his hands behind his back. Terracina asked what he did wrong and Ofc. Morris explained that he was under arrest for a theft that occurred at Shooterz Bar. Ofc. Morris explained to Terracina if he didn't put his hands behind his back he would be charged with an additional charge of resisting. Terracina continued to say he did nothing wrong and continued to tense his arms, thus refusing to put his hands behind his back. Eventually Terracina loosened his grip of his hands, and Ofc. Morris placed his left arm behind his back in a hammer lock position. Ofc. Morris asked Terracina to place his right hand behind his back multiple times. Ofc. Morris asked Terracina, who was still sitting on the ground, to roll over onto his stomach. Terracina rolled to his right side, with his right arm pinned in between his body and the ground. Ofc. Morris gave Terracina multiple loud verbal commands to roll onto his stomach and place his right hand behind his back. Terracina began to violently thrash his body around and tried multiple times to pull his left arm, which Ofc. Morris was still holding onto, from behind his back. Terracina used his right arm to push his body off the ground and tried to stand up. Ofc. Morris let go of Terracina's arm and separated himself from him. Ofc. Morris displayed his Taser again and told Terracina to put his hands behind his back. Terracina sat up to a squatting position and attempted to stand up. Due to the fact Ofc. Morris was placing Terracina into custody reference the theft at Shooterz Bar, and Terracina's physically evasive maneuvers, and his apparent attempt to flee back inside the house, Ofc. Morris deployed his Taser. The Taser achieved neuromuscular incapacitation (NMI) and Terracina fell to the ground. Ofc. Morris continued to give Terracina loud verbal commands to roll onto his stomach and put his hands behind his back. Terracina said he did not do anything wrong and refused to roll onto his back. Ofc. Morris issued another cycle with his Taser, again achieving NMI. Terracina immediately complied rolling onto his stomach at which point Ofc. Morris placed him into handcuffs without further incident.

While awaiting Rescue, I read Terracina the Miranda warning. Terracina waived his rights and agreed to speak with me. Terracina denied walking out on his tab at Shooterz and taking the cell phone. I explained to Terracina that I obtained video footage from Shooterz at which point Terracina confessed to taking the phone however denied stealing it. Terracina stated he found the phone sitting on the table. Terracina also denied walking out on his tab and stated he left money on the counter, contrary to the security footage. Terracina told me the phone was inside of his house at which point Terracina Sr. retrieved the phone for me.

Key West Fire Department Rescue 3 responded and transported Terracina to Lower Keys Medical Center. Ofc.

Morris accompanied Rescue 3 to assist with Terracina.

At the hospital, the ER doctor removed the probes from Terracina's leg and forearm. Shortly after, I was issued a Medial Exam Clearance Form for the jail's medical staff.

Terracina was transported to the Monroe County Detention Center without incident. At the jail, I instructed Terracina that he has been trespassed from Shooterz and should he return to the property he will be subject to arrest.

My BWC was activated throughout this call and will be uploaded to Evidence.com. A copy of the security camera footage will also be uploaded to Evidace.com. The recovered cell phone, a black Android Kyocera, will be placed into property under the status "Return to Owner".

Based on the facts and evidence and security camera footage from Shooterz, Louis Richard Terracina did knowingly and intentionally obtain Burge's cell phone with the intent to permanently deprive Burge of his rights to his cell phone; contrary to FSS 812.014 - Theft.

Louis Richard Terracina did also knowingly and intentionally obtain food and beverages from Shooterz, totaling \$26.20, with the intent to defraud the business thereof; contrary to FSS 509.151 - Obtaining Food or Lodging With Intent to Defraud.

Louis Richard Terracina did also knowingly and intentionally resist and oppose Ofc. Morris as he was lawfully executing an arrest without offering or doing violence to Ofc. Morris; contrary to FSS 843.02 - Resisting Officer Without Violence to His or Her Person.

On Tuesday, July 21, 2020, at 2021 hours, I (Officer Morris) responded to 1213 14th Street lot 120, in an attempt to locate a Louis Terracina. I responded as a backup officer for Officer Waite. I arrived at the home first.

Upon arrival, I parked my patrol vehicle three to four houses away from Louis' home. I approached the house on foot and saw Louis' father standing on the front porch. Louis exited the home and his father told him that the police were there and said they wanted to talk to him. Louis who could now see me approaching the home, yelled, "what the fuck do you want?" Louis exited the front porch and started approaching me. Note: Earlier in the evening Terracina fled from officers prior to their arrival. Given these circumstances, I believed Terracina had the apparent ability to flee on foot again. Terracina exited the porch. I displayed my Taser and gave Louis loud verbal commands to get on the ground. Louis stopped walking towards me and turned to go back on to the porch. Louis stumbled and I grabbed his left arm with my left hand and escorted him to the ground, in a controlled manner. I advised Louis to stay seated on the ground and put his hands behind his back. Louis was sitting on the ground with his hands gripped together. Louis refused to put his hands behind his back. Louis asked what he did wrong and I explained that he was under arrest for a theft that occurred at Shooters Bar. I explained to Louis if he didn't put his hands behind his back he would be charged with an additional charge of resisting. Louis continued to say he did nothing wrong and continued to tense his arms, thus refusing to put his hands behind his back. Eventually Louis loosened his grip of his hands, and I placed his left arm behind his back in a hammer lock position. I again asked Louis to place his right hand behind his back multiple times. I asked Louis, who was still sitting on the ground, to roll over onto his stomach. Louis rolled to his right side, with his right arm pinned in between his body and the ground. I gave Louis multiple loud verbal commands to roll onto his stomach and place his right hand behind his back. Louis began to violently thrash his body around and tried multiple times to pull his left arm, which I was still holding onto, from behind his back. Louis used his right arm to push his body off the ground and tried to stand up. I let go of Louis' arm and separated myself from Louis. I displayed my Taser again and told Louis to put his hands behind his back. Louis sat up to a squatting position and attempted to stand up. Due to fact I was placing Louis into custody reference the theft at Shooters Bar, and Louis' physically evasive maneuvers, and his apparent attempt to flee back inside the house, I deployed my Taser. The Taser achieved neuromuscular incapacitation (NMI) and Louis fell to the ground. I reevaluated the situation while continuing to give Louis multiple loud verbal commands to roll onto his stomach and put his hands behind his back. Louis said he did not do anything wrong and refused to roll onto his back. I gave Louis a second cycle with my Taser, once again achieving NMI. Louis immediately complied rolling onto his stomach. I placed him into handcuffs without further incident.

I rode with KWFR3 to LKMC with Louis as he was being treated for his injuries. Upon arrival to LKMC, Louis was treated for his injuries and I turned Louis over to Officer Waite.
