Re: September Monthly Report for Key West Historic Seaport

Key West Bight Operations:

• Harbor walk bathhouse project to be complete October 2020.

- Ferry Terminal Mobile Generator equipment installed. Waiting on manufacturer for startup and training.
- New transformers and pedestals for H3 dock will be installed October 2020.
- Task Order issued to Sea Tech of the Florida Keys for replacement of the Ferry Terminal main entrance doors. Doors have been delivered to site.
- Task Order issued to Sea Tech of the Florida Keys for replacement of the Ferry Terminal bathroom counters and sinks. Counter will be upgrade with a solid surface material.
- Task order issued to William Horn Architect for Ferry Terminal Landscaping Design.
- Staff receiving quotes for new Ferry Terminal site lighting to match Seaport.
- Task order issued to DN Higgins for site lighting foundations.

Key West Bight Marina:

- September transient dockage was down 4% compared to last September. There were several bad weather cancellations and the negative effects of Covid-19.
- Fuel sales were up 36% at the marina.
- Dinghy slip rentals are down 18% due to locals leaving town as a result of the Covid shutdown.
- Started trash removal below and around the docks as the water visibility improves.
- Ongoing piling fender and cleat replacement.
- September fuel systems got inspected and passed our annual recertification.
- 4,590 Passengers passed through the Ferry Terminal this September compared to 7,969 last September.
