

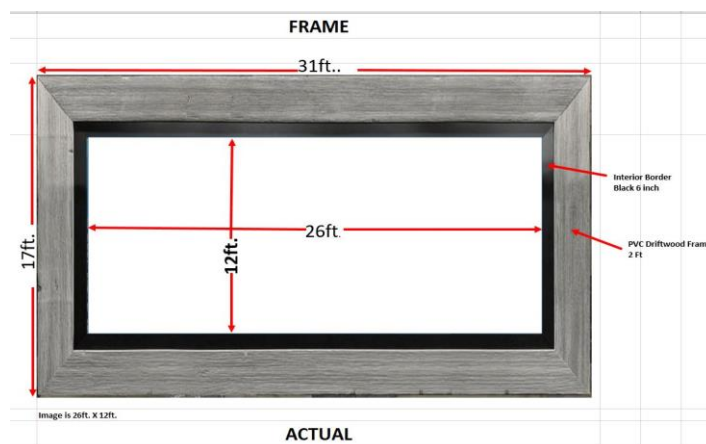

### PUBLIC ART PLAN

The Public Art Plan shall include the following:

1. Artist name and CV/resume as defined in subsection 2-487(b)  
K.C. Scott is an award winning professional artist and fisherman who began painting in Elementary school. His intriguing works of art blend his passion for the ocean and his love of fishing. He has won numerous awards and graced the cover of Marlin magazine. KC Scott Signature Gallery in Palm Beach highlights his original masterpieces displaying his mixture of real life scenes and imagination. No one brings the life of a fish to a canvas like K. C. Scott!
2. Description of proposed artwork – please include dimensions, materials and method of construction. The exterior piece will be a PVC board frame and backing shaped and painted to look like driftwood. There will be a dibond substrate which will be attached to the the PVC board. The dibond will be wrapped with a printed exterior on 3M material. Dimensions height is 17 ft x length 31 ft.

4. Detailed drawings, architect rendering or photographs of the specific site where artwork will be located. Details of utilities, proposed landscaping, parking, etc. is helpful

6. Statement on how maintenance and conservation will be handled  
 Materials used will be high grade aluminum and are equipped to withstand the elements. A non-yellowing varnish is used for an added layer of protection and will be reapplied if ever necessary. The Art will be inspected on a regular basis and if an additional layer of varnish must be reapplied K. C. Scott will be contacted to clean and apply the varnish. The lighting will be replaced in approximately 2 years. The driftwood frame is PVC and will be cleaned annually or before as needed.
7. Total construction cost as calculated by the City's Building Department to determine eligible 1% for public art program. **The 1% of construction costs equal \$87,010.90. Our donation exceeds the 1% totaling \$89,168.**
