1. **Truman Waterfront Park** – [Re-scheduled for October 6th](#) - Power point presentation for the City Commission meeting with Alison Higgins to receive “acceptance” of the Civic Moxie finished Master Arts & Culture plan for the park.
2. **Truman Waterfront Park** – [The Florida Keys Sculpture Trail now begins and ends in the Park. The artwork, “Wave Henge” by artists Damon Hamm and Jeff Sundheim was installed on September 13-14th by R.V.W. Sculpture Installation, Inc and coordinated by Liz and City Community services and Engineering departments. Toppino’s and Bella Construction completed the concrete pad \(paid with AIPP funds \\$12,000\).](#)
3. **1400 Duval Park/Mall** – [5 sculptures scheduled for installation on October 6th](#) – Tim Root is assisting Liz and the artists. Insurance/artist waivers under review by Legal dept. Also working with the City for new signage.
