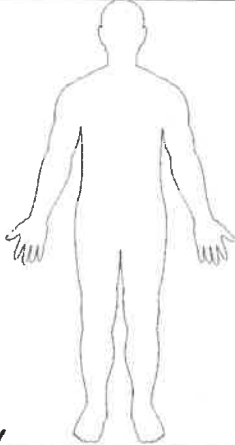

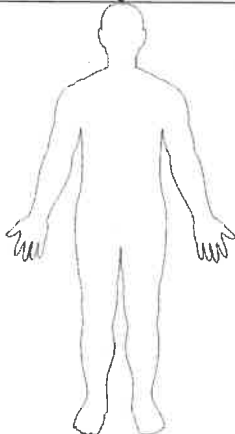

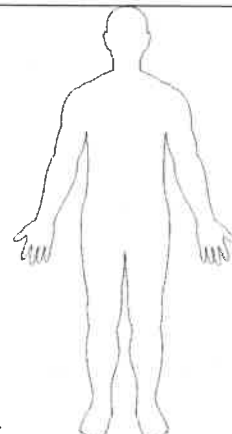

On Saturday, August 22, 2020 at 10:03 AM, I was dispatched to the Harvey Government Center at 1200 Truman Avenue for a quality of life issue. The reporting party, Denise Henriquez, told Key West Dispatch a white male, who was by the dumpsters, was acting erratic.

Officers G. Kouri, Dehanas, and I arrived at 10:10 AM. I recognized the male from an earlier call across the street at the Dion's Quick Mart at 1124 Truman Avenue. Officer Kouri and I were dispatched to the Dion's Quick Mart for a subject camping in the parking lot at 8:44 AM this day. We contacted Christopher Bounds who was organizing his belongings in the parking lot. Christopher had a makeshift shelter set up and was using the lids of the dumpster to shield himself from the rain. Officer Kouri and I told Christopher he needed to leave the property. Christopher started gathering his belongings. While gathering his belongings he was crying, dropping items, tripping over his stuff, and appeared upset. Christopher also showed signs of being under the influence of controlled substances: sweating profusely, paranoia, and erratic movements. Christopher eventually left the property.

At the Harvey Government Center, I observed Christopher setting up another shelter by a dumpster. Christopher still showed the same signs he was earlier in the morning. I made the decision to take Christopher into protective custody. Christopher was standing by the dumpster. I introduced myself, told him the police received more calls about his behavior, and told him I was going to take him to the hospital. I reached out to grab Christopher's right wrist. Christopher stiffened both of his arms and retracted them, with his elbows bent, to his side. Christopher also stiffened his back and backed toward the dumpster. I placed both my hands on Christopher's shoulders, pulled him toward my lower left leg, and escorted him to the ground in a controlled manner. Once on the ground Officers Dehanas, Kouri, and I struggled with Christopher for a moment while attempting to place handcuffs on him. Once cuffed, I noticed Christopher was kicking with his legs and spitting. I attached a hobble to control his legs then applied a spit mask over his face.

Officers Kasyanenko and Fernandez arrived on scene. Officer Fernandez requested rescue. Key West Rescue responded and decided to sedate Christopher who was still acting erratic. Christopher told Key West Rescue Personnel he was a schizophrenic. Key West Rescue transported Christopher to the emergency room at the Lower Keys Medical Center. Officer Kouri rode in the back of the ambulance. I filled out Baker Act paperwork at the ER.

I activated my KWPD issued bodycam on this call.
