TAX CREDIT AND LOW INCOME AFFORDABLE HOUSING



AH secured funding from Florida Housing Finance Corporation for the development of Marty's Place and Poinciana Royale for Low Income Housing other types of Tax Credit housing is Workforce Housing.
Ist step for any housing project – is site control! A minimum of a 50-year Land Use Restriction Agreement.
Funding is secured through a Request for Application (RFA) process based upon awards allocated to Florida counties. Small counties like Monroe County are often given bonus points for development.
Development and securing funding require a knowledgeable team consisting of:

1994 PRAC/SECTION 811 HOUSING



- PRAC properties were acquired through the HUD Capital Agreement Program in 1994.
- Unique to PRAC: rental assistance comes with the unit. The tenant pays 30% of household income towards rent; the program pays the rest.
- PRAC Section 811 requires one member of the household to be disabled.
- PRAC Section 811 Programs are for a 40-year term.
- Other PRAC programs: Section 202, for the elderly.



AH redevelopment of Seebol Place 2009 as a Housing First Project with funding from the Department of Children and Families for Homeless housing, State Housing Incentive Program (SHIP), Fundraising/Capital Campaign.
Seebol Place is for someone living with a homeless definition, at high risk for homelessness, substance abuse or mental health issues.
