Public Art Projects: **February updates in red –**

1. **1400 Duval Park/Mall** – Final sculpture – John Martini’s “Blue Teacher” (gift from Timyan family) has been restored – install on Jan. 26th. **Postponed until Feb. 9th** Working with Enid of HARC and city staff, and artist Reen Stanhouse for an iron/metal permanent park sign to replace temporary sign. **No further updates on the signage.**
2. **Mallory Square/ Zero Duval Street - Private/City** – Update: new meetings with Planning Director Katie Halloran and Enid Torregrosa (HARC) new focus and funding ideas – working with stakeholders, and 4 community meetings to gather feedback. Both a component of new plans and team for Duval Revitalization.
3. **Douglass Gym Expansion** – **no updates.** Attended January BVRAC mtg by zoom – moving forward slowly with design plans
4. **Private/Public – CHI Health Clinic at Douglass Band Room** – **no updates.** working with Marianne Finizio to determine 1% and best practices for calls for proposals for 1% for public art as the Clinic is now a MDP. Construction/renovations have begun.
5. **KW Seaport Public Art project** – **no updates.** RFP has been approved and final edits completed by Administrator. Postponed indefinitely to Covid-19.
6. **AIPP Ordinance review** – will to set up a meeting with Marianne and City Assistant Attorney, George Wallace. **Need to schedule a mutual date to meet**
7. **Collections Management** – will work with City staff to create and update City collection/inventory app ready to go, need to work with each board member **-ongoing**

9. **Gift from Timyan family** – **see # 1 above for 1400. Seeking permission and permit to install the “White Bird” at Truman Waterfront Park.**

11. Possible long-term loan of a Frank Stella sculpture for Truman Waterfront Park – **No updates**
