I encountered a subject, who we know through several previous law enforcement encounters as Alexandra Ricciardelli. Ricciardelli is well known to be an annoyance towards the community, partake in drug and alcohol abuse, as well other miscellaneous crimes that corrupt the public sense of morals.

Ricciardelli also continuously attempted to stand up and walk between me and the other detainees, asking for her identification to be returned. Ricciardelli constantly attempted to speak over me and yelled obscenities at me while I was explaining the trespass violation, as well as the other ordinance violations.

As I placed Ricciardelli in handcuffs, she attempted to pull away from me and refused to place her right arm behind her back. I was eventually able to place her right wrist in the handcuff and I walked her to the transport van. I searched Ricciardelli.

I transported Ricciardelli to Monroe County Detention Center. Ricciardelli yelled and screamed obscenities throughout the encounter and transport to Monroe County Detention Center.

Key West Police Department has authorization to trespass from the entire shopping center at 335 Duval Street, including units A through F (Wendy's through to the old Key West Cigar Club & Smoke Shop).

Ricciardelli appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. Ricciardelli's speech was slurred, and her eyes were glassy and bloodshot. Ricciardelli's breath had the odor of alcoholic intoxicants.

Ricciardelli was arrested on 12/22/2020 from 500 Duval Street for Misdemeanor Battery for which she is on probation/supervised release with special conditions of no alcohol and illegal drugs. Ricciardelli has a non-extraditable, instate pick-up only active arrest warrant for Failure to Appear for Trespassing from Chatham County, Savannah Georgia. Ricciardelli has a non-extraditable, instate pick-up only active arrest warrant for Failure to Appear for Possession of Controlled Substance from Washington County, Arkansas. Ricciardelli has a non-extraditable, instate pick-up only active arrest warrant for Failure to Appear for Misdemeanor Theft from Rogers County, Arkansas. Rowlett ignored me and remained on scene, diverting my attention from the group and on to her. Due to Rowlett opposing multiple lawful orders to leave the area, Ofc. Dantu and Ofc. Waite approached the female and attempted to take her into custody. Hoffman immediately hovered over the top of Rowlett, in an attempt to prevent the Officers from taking her into custody. Ofc. Dantu, Ofc. Waite, and I attempted to separate the two subjects but were met with both passive and active resistance. Because of this, Ofc. Waite deployed his pepper spray striking Hoffman in the face, allowing us to separate the two from one another. Rowlett was contaminated with residue pepper spray due to the struggle that ensued however, Rowlett was not injured.

I placed Rowlett into handcuffs. Ofc. Dantu and Ofc. Waite placed Hoffman in handcuffs. Ofc. Waite and Sgt. Vazquez searched Hoffman incident to arrest and located an X-Acto Knife in a pocket on the left side of his coat. It should be noted, this is the same side of Hoffman that Rowlett sat by before proceeding to place her hands inside his coat. Sgt. Vazquez and Ofc. Dantu secured Rowlett and Hoffman in the transport van.

I transported Rowlett to Monroe County Detention Center, without incident.

Rowlett was issued a trespass warning for 335 Duval Street on 02/07/2021 at approximately 2127 hours.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on 02/07/2021, Brittany N. Rowlett did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 843.02 Resisting Officer without Violence, by purposely attempting to obstruct my investigation and attempting to pull away from Ofc. Dantu, Ofc. Waite and me while we were engaged in our legal, lawful duties as uniformed law enforcement officers.

My BWC was activated for the use of force, arrest and subsequent search of Hoffman. The In-Car COBAN in the transport van was malfunctioning. I activated my BWC for Rowlett's transport. I uploaded the videos to Evidence.com.

At this time, no further information.

On February 7, 2020, at approximately 2127 hours, I, Ofc. Waite, was dispatched to 335 Duval Street as back up for Ofc. Howell. Dispatch advised Ofc. Howell was out with four subjects.

On arrival, I observed a group of subjects sitting on a stairway in front of 335 Duval Street. One of the subjects, identified later as Stephen Hoffman, was holding an approximately 6-foot-long bamboo stick. I instructed Hoffman to drop the stick and he complied immediately. I remained on scene as Ofc. Howell conducted his trespassing investigation. During the investigation, a female, identified later as Alexandra Ricciardelli, continuously interrupted and berated Ofc. Howell in a belligerent manner. Her behavior incited Hoffman to do the same. A female, identified later as Brittney Rowlett, approached Hoffman and sat next to him, taking Hoffman's attention away from Ofc. Howell, who was speaking to the group. As Rowlett sat next to Hoffman, she placed both of her hands inside of the long cloak-like jacket he was wearing. Ofc. Howell asked Rowlett to walk away, as she was obstructing his investigation. Rowlett refused, stating Hoffman was her husband. Ofc. Dantu, Ofc. Howell, and I each ordered Rowlett to walk away and she continuously defied our lawful orders. Ofc. Dantu and I approached Rowlett to take her into custody for obstructing Ofc. Howell's investigation. As we attempted to take control of Rowlett's arms, she pulled away. Hoffman stood up from a seated position and threw his body over the top of Rowlett assuming the fetal position. Ofc. Dantu immediately grabbed ahold Hoffman and ordered him off Rowlett. Hoffman refused and continued to resist and oppose Ofc. Dantu's lawful order. It should be noted that Hoffman is 6' 7" tall and weighs approximately 260 pounds. As Hoffman continued to passively and actively resist Ofc. Dantu's lawful orders and attempts to gain control of the situation, I unholstered my department issued OC spray. Due to Hoffman looking down and away from me, I grabbed him by the hair, pulled his head backward, and delivered a burst of OC spray. The initial burst struck Hoffman in the top part of his scalp with negative effect. I delivered a second burst of OC spray, this time striking Hoffman in the face. The OC sprayed instantly took effect allowing Ofc. Howell, Ofc. Dantu, and I to separate the two and take them into custody.

Sgt. Vazquez and I searched Rowlett, incident to arrest, prior to placing him into the Key West Police Department Transport Van. Sgt. Vazquez located a precision razor blade in a pocket on the left side of his cloak.

This was the extent of my involvement.

When I arrived, Ofc. Howell was attempting to explain to the group of people consisting of three males and one female that they were trespassing and that pan handling was illegal. The female person continued to interrupt Ofc. Howell. The male on the end closest to Eaton Street began to interrupt Ofc. Howell and would not allow Ofc. Howell to finish his explanation of why they were being detained.

Ofc. Waite arrived on scene.

A female with long blonde dreadlocks approached the group and sat next to the male person closest to Eaton Street.

Ofc. Waite and Ofc. Howell asked the female with long blonde dreadlocks to leave. Ofc. Howell and Ofc. Waite tried to explain that they were conducting Police business and that she needed to move away from the group. The female with the long blonde dreadlocks refused to leave.

Ofc. Waite and I attempted to escort the female with blonde dreadlocks away from group that was being detained. The male person sitting closest to Eaton Street reached out and grabbed the female with the long blonde dreadlocks. The female with the long blonde dreadlocks grabbed hold of the male and the two of them would not let go of each other. The male person attempted to stand up. Ofc. Howell and I attempted to stop the male person from standing up. Ofc. Howell and I tried to release his hold on the female with the long blonde dreadlocks.

Ofc. Waite administered his oleoresin capsicum spray toward the male who was attempting to stand up and keep his grip on the female with the long blonde dreadlocks.

The male, after putting up a struggle and resisting my attempts and Ofc. Howell's attempts to separate him from the female with long blonde dreadlocks eventually released his grip and laid down on the ground. The male was detained and placed in handcuffs by Ofc. Howell, Ofc. Waite and myself.

The female with long blonde dreadlocks was detained and placed in handcuffs.

Sgt. Vasquez, Ofc. Ham and Ofc. Malak arrived on scene.

KWFR arrived on scene and attended to the female with long blonde dreadlocks and the male person who resisted KWPD attempts to release his grip on the female with long blonde dreadlocks.
