On 02/23/2021 at approximately 0348 hours, I (Ofc. R. Roscoe) was dispatched to 201 William St. for a possible burglary.

When I arrived, Ofc. R. Perez and Ofc. Hernandez were already on-scene. and had the suspect Cory James Mixon detained. Mixon was searched and placed into the back of my patrol car.

The witness, Cory Robert Grandy (later identified by a FL DL) told Ofc. Dantu that he witnesses Mixon attempt to climb over a handrail on the side of the building. In doing so he broke several on the metal cross bars on the handrail.

Ofc. R. Perez told me that he and Ofc. Hernandez found Mixon asleep on a bench by the upstairs bar of the business. This was well after the regular business hours of the restaurant.

Mixon claimed he was hit in the head when being taken into custody by Ofc. R. Perez and Ofc. Hernandez, Sgt. Sims was notified, and KWFR was dispatched to assess Mixon.

KWFR arrived and determined Mixon needed no medical attention. Sgt. Sims informed me as a precaution to take Mixon to Lower Keys Medical Center to have him cleared. I transported Mixon to LKMC without incident.

Mixon was cleared by the staff at LKMC. I then transported Mixon to MCDC without incident

I had been out with the Mixon at approximately 0150 at Schooner Wharf when he attempted to steal a small bottle of champagne from a cooler but was caught by one of the staff. The bar did not want to peruse charges, they only wanted to have him trespassed for the property.

Ofc. Dantu took pictures using Axon Capture and uploaded them as evidence.

My in car Coban recorded the above interaction my BWC malfunctioned and did not record.

Cory James Mixon did knowingly and willingly commit the offense of criminal mischief F.S. 806.12.1B3 by breaking the handrail when attempting to climb over it in attempt to gain access to the Waterfront Brewery after normal business hours. The estimated cost of repairs to the handrail is \$1,200.00-\$1,500.00.

Cory James Mixon did knowingly and willingly commit the offense of trespassing F.S 810.08 by knowingly and willingly entering the property of the Waterfront Brewery without permission at a time that would be considered by reasonable and prudent person.

Nothing further at this time.

On 02/23 /2021, at 0350 hours, Ofc. Roscoe, Ofc. L. Hernandez and I (Ofc. R. Perez) were dispatched to The Waterfront Brewery in reference to a potential burglary in progress.

Upon arrival, a bouncer from Schooner Wharf later identified by his Florida DL as Cory Grandy, stated the suspect was on top of The Waterfront Brewery. Ofc Hernandez and I walked up the stairs, drew our duty pistols and began to search for the suspect. We found the suspect, laying down in a chair. We have encountered the suspect several times throughout the night and he was previously identified as Cory Mixon. Mixon was given several loud verbal commands to get down on the ground. Mixon refused to comply so I holstered my gun after I was able to determine that Mixon was not in possession of a weapon. I approached Mixon and grabbed his right forearm and pulled him out of the chair using an arm drag takedown to redirect him to the ground in a controlled manner. Mixon ended up in a supine position (face up). Ofc. Hernandez gave Mixon several loud repetitive verbal commands to roll over onto his stomach. Mixon complied and was placed in handcuffs which were double locked and checked for tightness. We walked Mixon to our marked patrol vehicles and he started to claim that we struck him in the head.

Ofc. Roscoe contacted KYPD Dispatch and asked for an ambulance to respond to our location. Rescue 2 arrived on scene, examined Mixon, determined he was uninjured and was not struck in the head.

I contacted Sgt. Sims asked if he would respond to my location in reference to an RRI. Sgt. Sims arrived on scene and I explained what actions I took in redirecting Mixon to the ground in a controlled manner.

My AXON BWC was activated during this incident.

On Sunday February 23, 2021, at about 348 am, while on a detail at Conch Harbor (951 Caroline Street), I went over to assist Ofc. J. Roscoe and Ofc. R. Perez, in reference to a burglary of a structure incident at 201 William Street (Waterfront Brewery).

Upon arrival, Ofc. Perez was informed by a witness that the suspect was upstairs on the rooftop of the Waterfront Brewery. Ofc. Perez and I walked upstairs and when we made it to the last flight of stairs, I saw the suspect, Cory James Mixon (DOB 07/14/1983), laying down on one of the chairs and I pointed my flashlight light on him.

Mixon sat up and Ofc. Perez ordered him to get on the ground several times. Mixon mumbled something that sounded incoherent and did not comply. I told Mixon to get on the ground as well and he did not comply. Ofc. Perez proceeded to grab Mixon by his right shoulder and right arm as he was ordering Mixon to get down on the ground. Ofc. Perez then redirected Mixon to the ground in a controlled manner. Nixon almost immediately complained about Ofc. Perez hitting him on his head. I did not observe Ofc. Perez hit Mixon on his head.

Once on the ground I grabbed Mixon`s arms and I assisted Ofc. Perez place him in handcuffs. We walked Mixon downstairs. I conducted an incident to arrest search of Mixon and placed him in the back on Ofc. Roscoe patrol vehicle.

My BWC 3452 was activated during this incident. Nothing else to report. This is a supplemental report.
