SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

- 1. The City shall pay \$200,000.00 to Plaintiff Stephen Schumann for his personal injury claim.
- 2. Plaintiff Laurie Margolin shall dismiss her Loss of Consortium claim with prejudice.

- 3. A Release of All Claims signed by both plaintiffs to the benefit of the City of Key West shall be incorporated and made part of this Settlement Agreement forthwith.
- 4. Plaintiffs agree to execute a *Dismissal with Prejudice* of the above styled cause of action within 5 business days of receiving payment from the City of Key West, or its insurance company.
- 5. The parties agree that the amounts in paragraph 1 represents good and valuable consideration for this Settlement Agreement.
