## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA), APPROVING A TWO YEAR RENEWAL TO THE "MASTER AGREEMENT" BETWEEN THE CRA AND SEA KEYS, TECH OF THE FLORIDA INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES - KEY WEST HISTORIC SEAPORT : AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 18-193, the CRA awarded a contract to Sea Tech of the Florida Keys, Inc. for construction services at the Key West Historic Seaport; and

WHEREAS, the Master Agreement was for an initial period of three years, with an option included in Article 4 for additional two-year terms at the discretion of the CRA, and City staff recommends exercising the two-year renewal option; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: That a two-year renewal of the "Master Agreement" between the CRA and Sea-Tech of the Florida Keys, Inc. for Construction Services for the Key West Historic Seaport is hereby approved.

<u>Section 2</u>: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents that are consistent with the approval granted herein, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney. Section 3: Specific task orders issued pursuant to the contracts shall comply with the City's procurement guidelines.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
