Public Art Projects: **March updates in green – April in Purple – May in Red**

1. **Smathers Beach – Debra Yates’ Mosaic Wall** – met with City Engineer Johnnie Yongue to determine viability of the artwork. Emails and calls with Artist. Proposal for repairs on today’s Agenda for the Board’s consideration. **For Approval today. For Approval today**
2. **1400 Duval Park/Mall** – John Martini’s “Teach” (gift from Timyan family) has been restored and installed. All sculptures and artwork signs installed. No further updates on the signage for the Park – working with HARC. **Working with HARC and City Staff And now Rosi and Parks & Rec**
3. **Mallory Square/ Zero Duval Street - Private/City** – Planning Director Katie Halloran and Enid Torregrosa (HARC) are holding 3 community meetings scheduled for 3/11, 3/25, 4/7 to gather feedback. Both a component of new plans and team for Duval Revitalization. **Some of Duval on pause – last workshop is on April 15<sup>th</sup> please note date change. Ongoing discussion/planning**
4. **Douglass Gym Expansion** – Watched both February and March BVRAC mtgs by zoom – design plans approved and moved onto HARC, being reviewed a second time by HARC. **Many updates expected at March 31 City Commission and April 1 BVRAC meetings. Back to BVRAC on May 6.**
5. **Private/Public – CHI Health Clinic at Douglass Band Room** – Construction underway, continue to work with Marianne Finizio -she has asked Terry Justice/Building Dept. to calculate 1% and Marianne will work with Architect to determine “targeted spaces”, to bring proposal to AIPP. **No new updates Ongoing -waiting on determination of \$\$\$ and spaces**
6. **KW Seaport** Public Art project – **no updates.** RFP has been approved and final edits completed by Administrator. Postponed indefinitely to Covid-19. **No updates No updates**
7. **AIPP Ordinance review** – will to set up a meeting with Marianne and City Assistant Attorney, George Wallace. **Need to schedule a mutual date to meet. No new updates**
8. **Collections Management** – will work with City staff to create and update City collection/inventory app ready to go, need to work with each board member –ongoing **Michael Marrero will photograph the collection for the APP – he would contract with us for a reduced fee -\$35/hour**
9. **Ongoing Projects spreadsheet** – ongoing –
10. **Gift from Timyan family** – see # 1 above for 1400. Seeking permission and permit to install the “White Bird” at Truman Waterfront Park or *proposed Indigenous Park*. **For discussion DISCUSS**
